1# DIVISION SPECIAL PROGRAM IN JOURNALISM ACADEMY

- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act No. 7079 also known as the "Campus Journalism Act of 1991," the Division of Aklan through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) shall conduct the 1st Division Special Program in Journalism Academy with the theme, "Empowering 21st Century Aklanon Journalists for National Transformation" on September 21-22, 2019 at Tangalan Elementary School, Tangalan, Aklan.
- 2. The academy aims to provide holistic and responsive learning opportunities to learners through meaningful experiences in campus journalism. Specifically, the academy shall serve as a venue for young journalists to:
 - a. enhance their journalistic competence through capacitating their skills such in individual writing, radio broadcasting, TV newscasting; and collaborative desktop-publishing;
 - b. demonstrate understanding of the importance of journalism by expressing it through different journalistic endeavours and approaches; and
 - c. share ideas, experiences and practices of each implementing schools to help improve each schools' implementation.
- 3. The participating schools are the Special Program implementers and early implementers. For the elementary level: Balete IS, Buruanga ES, Bulwang ES, and Kalibo Pilot ES, and in the secondary level: Balete IS, Linabuan NHS, Makato IS, Ondoy NHS, Rizal B, Rodriquez MNHS, and Tamalagon IS. The delegates are expected to be at the venue on September 21 at 8:00 o'clock in the morning. Early confirmation and registration with the committee is highly encouraged.
- 4. The activities shall include the following workshops:
 - a. individual writing;
 - b. Scriptwriting and Radio Broadcasting;
 - c. Scriptwriting and TV Newscasting;
 - d. Collaborative Desktop Publishing; and

- e. other journalism related activities such as: Team Building, SPJ Campus Journalism Elections, SPJ Got Talent, Search for SPJ Q and A, Eucharist, Amazing Journey Race and the like.
- 5. Participants shall pay a registration fee of Three Hundred Pesos (Php 300.00) to cover expenses for the conduct of the academy which includes journalism kits, T-shirt, and other incidental, expenses charged to School Campus Journalism Fund, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.
- 6. Participation to this academy shall be given service credits/compensatory time-off per DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003.
