- 1. The Department of Education, Division of Aklan, in collaboration with the Regional Association of Technology and Livelihood Educators (RATLE) VI Aklan Chapter, will conduct the **2017 Division Technolympics** on December 7-8, 2017 with the theme "Pagkilala sa Kulturang Filipino Tungo sa Kapayapaan, Pagkakaisa at Pagbabago." This shall be held at Aklan National High School for Arts and Trades, Andagaw, Kalibo, Aklan.
- 2. The objective of this activity is to provide opportunities for pupils and students to showcase their talents and learning in Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE) and Technical Vocational Education (TVE) through an exhibition of their products and performances.
- 3. This activity is participated in by the first place winners in district-level/school-level contest, district supervisors/principals/head teacher in-charge of the district, school heads, TLE/TVE department heads, EPP/TLE coordinators, coaches and students.
- 4. A registration fee of one hundred fifty pesos (Php 100.00) will be charged to each student and adult participant to defray expenses for honoraria of the board of judges, certificates, medals and other expenses relevant to the conduct of this activity.
- 5. The registration fee, travel expenses, per diems and other incidental expenses relative to the attendance to this activity are chargeable against local school funds and other sources of funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 6. To determine the exact number of participants to be accommodated by the host schools, the TLE/TVE coordinators are advised to register their participants on December 1-5, 2017. Attention: Mrs. Marivic I. Tolentino, Education Program Supervisor in charge of this activity.

- 7. The contestants are required to wear plain white T-shirt and maong pants during the contest. The coaches may wear their school/district uniform during the opening program at 3:00 o' clock in the afternoon on December 7, 2017 and plain white T-shirt with collar during the contest proper on December 8, 2017.

GENERAL GUIDELINES ON THE CONDUCT OF THE 2017 DIVISION TECHNOLYMPICS

- 1. The participants of the 2017 Division Technolympics will showcase their best products, services and performances in the different events as evidence of their learning in the different learning areas.
- 2. The participants are winners in the school-based/district competitions and are currently enrolled in the public secondary schools (Junior and Senior High Schools) for SY 2017-2018. They are enrolled on/passed the specialization aligned with the contest category.
- 3. Only one entry per district: shall be accepted in Cookery.
- 4. For other skills contests, there will be a maximum of nineteen (19) entries. The first 19 participants on the specific contest category will be accepted.
- 5. The contestants will bring all the tools, equipment and materials needed for the contest as agreed during the meeting of TLE/TVE coordinators last November 18, 2017.
- 6. Implementing guidelines on the conduct of the 2017 Division Technolympics shall be based on DepEd Memorandum No. 160, s. 2017entitled "2018 National Festival of Talents."
- 7. All clarifications, issues and concerns relative to the Division Technolympics shall be addressed during the orientation after the opening program on December 7, 2017.
