

2017 GLOBAL HANDWASHING DAY CELEBRATION

To: Schools Division Superintendents
Division SBM Coordinators
School Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

- 1. Pursuant to the United Nation's (UN) declaration of a Global Hand-washing Day (every October 15th) and Philippine House of Representatives Resolution No. 1436 otherwise known as the "Implementation of Annual Global Handwashing Day", *Global Handwashing Day (GHD) Celebration* has been institutionalized in all schools of Region VI.
- 2. Global Handwashing Day (GHD) is a campaign to motivate and mobilize millions around the world to wash their hands with soap. The campaign is dedicated to raising awareness of handwashing with soap as a key approach to disease prevention. This year's theme, "Our Hands, Our Future!" emphasizes the importance of regular handwashing since our hands are the easiest carriers of germs being constantly in physical contact with something or someone.
- 3. Global Handwashing Day is also an opportunity to design, test, and replicate creative ways to encourage people to wash their hands with soap at critical times, thus, schools and Schools Divisions are encouraged to innovate activities in order to make the celebration more meaningful to learners, teachers, parents and the community.
- 4. The Regional Office will once again award the schools with remarkable and creative way of celebrating the Global Handwashing Day. Prizes for this year's best implementer will be disclosed in a separate memorandum.
- A consolidated narrative report on Global Hand-washing Day celebration shall be submitted by Division SBM Coordinators to the Regional Office c/o Regional SBM-WinS Coordinator not later than 30 days after the celebration.
- 6. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
