1. In compliance with Section 1, Rule 2 of RA 7079, also known as the Campus Journalism Act of 1991, the Department of Education is mandated to conduct the annual division, regional and national trainings and press conferences. This Office, in coordination with the Division Elementary and Secondary School Paper Advisers Association (DESSPAA) Aklan, announces the holding of the following activities:

2. The trainings aimed to hone the talents of campus journalists and to prepare them for higher competitions, especially for the 2017 Regional Schools Press Conference.
3. There will be contests after the lectures with each team composed of seven (7) pupils/students members. There are three categories each team can choose to join: English, Filipino and Akeanon. Each team is also advised to bring its laptops, gadgets and printers, for their sound effects and script encoding.
4. For Collaborative Publishing, each team must also have seven (7) pupils/students members and each team is also advised to provide their own laptop, printer and camera. There are two categories each team can choose to: English and Filipino.

5. A registration fee of two hundred (200.00) shall be charged each participant to cover rental of the venue, sound system, certificates and other incidental expenses.
6. There will be a separate date and venue for the 2017 Division Schools Press Conference.



7. The participants to these contests are school winners/qualifiers/members of school publication editorial board in the elementary and secondary levels. Senior High School students will compete with the Junior High School students.
8. The following are the contests categories, to wit:
 1. News Writing and *Pagsulat ng Balita*
 2. Editorial Writing and *Pagsulat ng Pangulong Tudling*
 3. Feature Writing and *Pagsulat ng Lathalain*
 4. Sports Writing and *Pagsulat ng Balitang Pampalakasan*
 5. Copy Reading and Headline Writing and *Pagwawasto ng Sipi at Pag-uulo ng Balita*
 6. Science and Technology Writing and *Pagsulat ng Pang agham at Pangteknolohiyang Balita*
 7. Editorial Cartooning and *Kartung Pang-Editoryal*
 8. Photojournalism and *Larawang Pampahayagan* (Any point and shoot camera with a maximum of 20 mega pixels will be required; no DSLR camera will be allowed. Contestants should also provide their own laptops, camera cable for the transfer of their photos and encoding of their captions).
9. Radio Broadcast and Scriptwriting (English and Filipino) – elementary and secondary levels.
10. *TV Newscast and Scriptwriting (English and Filipino) – Elementary and secondary level (it should be clear that TV Newscast for Elementary has no higher level competition. However, participation of all schools is still encouraged.*
11. Only ONE pupil/student journalist per participating school will be allowed to participate in every individual writing contests in the same medium; likewise for Radio Broadcast, only ONE (1) team composed of seven (7) participants shall be allowed to participate in every medium.
12. It is also understood that all the cameras, gadgets, extension cords, laptops and other needed equipment needed for photojournalism and radio broadcast will be provided by participating contestant/teams.
13. A registration fee of Fifty pesos (50.00) and a membership of thirty pesos (30.00) shall be charged each participant to cover expenses for sounds, certificates, extra-duty allowance for judges and facilitators.

14. Those who are interested to join the school paper contest must submit during the registration two (2) copies of an issue of their school paper. This may be last school year's issue or this school year's first quarter issue.
