1. In line with the Division program in commemorating the nationalism and martyrdom of our great national hero Dr. Jose P. Rizal and in giving importance to population for sustainable development, this Office will conduct the **Rizal Quiz Bee and On-the-Spot Skills Exhibition on PopDev in Araling Panlipunan** (PopQuiz, PopDebate, Jingle Writing and Singing and Poster Making) on **Thursday, November 29, 2018 at 7:30 A.M- 5:00 P.M at the APSTA Center, Kalibo, Aklan.**

2. The following are the activities:

3. The Rizal Activity aims to:

- honor and appreciate the life and writings of Rizal, hero of the youth and our national hero;
- bring the Filipinos together as they immortalize Rizal and ponder upon his significance in contemporary times ; and
- enhance self-confidence, patriotic values and sportsmanship.

4. The On-the-Spot Skills Exhibition on PopDev aims to:

- convey the population and the development concepts and messages to the youth ;
- make the learners become responsible and productive members of the community; and
- provide opportunities for elementary and secondary learners to showcase their talents and learnings in Araling Panlipunan through an exhibition of their skills and performance.

5. The contestants are the following:
  - a. Rizal Quiz- one (1) contestant from each public and private Junior High School (Grade 9/Grade 10 only).
  - b. Pop Ed Quiz -one (1) Junior/Senior High School contestant from each public and private Junior / Senior High School.
  - c. PopDev Debate- one (1) contestant from each district (Junior/Senior High School)
  - d. Poster Making Contest- one (1) contestant from each district public/private Elementary School.
  - e. Jingle Writing and Singing Contest- one (1) unit champion/representative from public/ private Junior/Senior High School .
  
6. A **registration fee of fifty pesos** (Php 50.00) per contestant and coach will be collected to defray other incidental expenses for the said activities not included in the Provincial Support Education Fund.
  
7. The **champion** in the different Population Development Competitions will represent the division in the **2019 Regional On-the-Spot Skills Exhibition on Population Development**, date and venue will be announced later.
  
8. The board of judges, committee workers and contest mechanics are found in the enclosures.

**Implementing Guidelines on the 2018 On-the-Spot Skills Exhibition on Population Development in Arafing Panlipunan**

- A. Event Package** - Pop Quiz  
**Grade Level** - Junior/Senior High School  
**No. of Contestant** - One (1)  
**Description** - Quiz is based on the following Population Education Core Messages/Key Concepts:  
A. Family Life and Responsible Parenthood  
B. Gender and Development  
C. Population and Reproductive Health  
D. Population, Environment, Resources and Sustainable Development
- Criteria for Assessment** - Easy Round - 1 point per correct answer  
- Average Round - 2 points per correct answer  
- Difficult Round - 3 points per correct answer

**Event Rules and Mechanics**

- a. The contestant must wear his/her complete school uniform with identification card during the contest.
  - b. The formulation of the test questions at the local, regional and national levels shall be based on the Population Education Core Messages and Key Concepts mentioned above.
  - c. Review materials for the Pop Quiz will be provided by the Department of Education or Commission on Population.
  - d. During the quiz, participants will be provided with answer sheets.
  - e. English or Filipino will be used as the official language in the conduct of the quiz.
  - f. Participants will be given a total number of twenty (20) questions, of which six (6) are easy, seven (7) are average, and seven (7) are difficult.
  - g. Participants shall be given ten (10) seconds to answer each question. For questions that require computation, participants shall be given a maximum of thirty (30) seconds.
  - h. The quizmaster will only read each question twice. Countdown will start after the question has been read the second time and the quizmaster says GO. When the quizmaster says STOP or TIME IS UP, contestants must raise their pens.
  - i. A participant shall be allowed to change his/her answer within the allotted time.
  - j. In case of a tie, a clincher question drawn from the difficult category shall be asked until a winner emerges.
  - k. In case of protest or inquiry during the actual quiz proceedings, the following procedures shall be observed:
    - Only the contestant or the official coach of the participant is allowed to raise a protest or inquiry before the next question is read. The protest or inquiry will be addressed orally to the chair of the board of judges who will recognize the protest or inquiry.
    - The chair will announce the decision upon deliberation with the members of the board of judges.
  - l. The decision of the Board of Judges is final.
- B. Event Package** - Pop Dev Debate  
**Grade Level** - Junior/Senior High School  
**No. of Contestants** - One (1) per district  
**Description** - The event is a combination of argumentation and debate that is conducted in a modified round table discussion. It enables the contestant to use his/her critical analysis and deep reasoning about the different issues that occur in the society.

### **Event Rules and Mechanics**

#### **Round – Table Argumentation and Debate**

The event is a combination of argumentation and debate that is conducted in a round table discussion. It enables the contestant to use his critical analysis and deep reasoning about the different issues that occur in the society. This also develops the ability of the students to organize his ideals promptly and logically.

The event shall follow the rules and guidelines below:

- A. There shall only be one (1) contestant/debater from each district. The debator shall be accompanied and trained by the duly approved coach.
- B. Each contestant shall wear a corporate attire. Moreover, they are required to present their valid school ID during registration.
- C. Contestants shall be assigned a number that will correspond to the number on the judging sheet.
- D. Topics to be debated shall revolve on the following issues: country's foreign and economic policies, environment, gender and society, governance, peace and order, population and reproductive health, and other current/contemporary issues.
- E. The debater is required to use the English language as a medium except for terminologies on certain topics that are only stated in Filipino.
- F. The debate will consist of two rounds:

#### **Round 1: Elimination Round**

- A. Each debater will be given a maximum of 3 minutes to deliver his/her speech on the topic drawn.
- B. After the discourse of the first contestant/debater, the second debater will interpolate on the speech of the first debater. The questions for the interpolation will be focused on the arguments of the opponent. Categorical questions will be allowed (Answerable by YES or NO), however, the responder may choose to qualify or not his/her answer. A total of five (5) minutes shall be allotted to other contestants to ask their clarifications, rebuttal and other questions.
- C. The second contestant will also give his/her speech on the topic, the third debater will be asking questions to debater 2, debater 3 will be asked by debater 4, debater 4 by debater 5, debater 5 by debater 6 and so on.

#### **Round 2: Final Round**

- D. After the first round, eight (8) debaters will be chosen to proceed to the second round. The debaters will be following the same order as the first round.
- E. A new topic for debate will be given on the second round. The topics will also be selected from the issues enumerated previously during the first round.
- F. The same process from round 1 (letter C) shall be followed.
- G. Prompting and coaching during the duration of the debate shall be strictly prohibited.

h. The criteria for judging are:

Delivery .....	20%
(tone of voices, use of gestures, and level of enthusiasm are convincing to others)	
Use of Supporting Evidence .....	25%
(examples and facts to support reasons with references)	
Organization .....	25%
(view points and responses are outlined both clearly and orderly)	
Reasoning and Ability to Answer.....	30%
(reasons are given to support viewpoints, arguments made by the other are responded to and dealt with effectively)	
<b>Total .....</b>	<b>100%</b>

**Event Rules and Mechanics**

- a. The theme of the showcase will be announced on the actual day of the skills exhibition.
- b. The order of the presentation shall be determined through draw lots, this will be done during the registration.
- c. The jingle must be an original composition highlighting the theme. Lyrics must be in English.
- d. Performance must be done in acapella within two(2) to three(3) minutes.
- e. Contestant shall wear t-shirt and pants but must present valid identification card during the registration.

**Event Rules and Mechanics**

- a. The contestants shall draw their numbers during registration. They will be given a number tag which will be attached to the poster.
- b. The theme of the showcase will be announced on the actual day of the skills exhibition.
- c. Any artwork in the poster must be original in design.
- d. The contestant shall be provided with ¼ illustration board to be used in the skills exhibition. He/she may use any painting materials for the said event.

**General Mechanics**

- A. The student-contestants shall wear their complete school uniform(with identification card) during the contest.
- B. The contestant's personal belongings such as bags, cellphones, tablet PCs, and writing and information materials shall be left in a designated area in the venue/to the coach during the course of the contest.
- C. The coaches of the students are advised to occupy the designated place at the venue. During the course of the contest, private communications between or among students and their respective coaches and/or their supporters are not allowed.
- D. The results of the contest as proclaimed by the Board of Judges will be final and executory.
- E. Winners shall be awarded medal and certificate right after the contest.

**Reading Mechanics**

- F. Each question will be read twice by the Quizmaster in English.
- G. After the second reading, the Quizmaster shall say the word "go", only then the contestants will be allowed to write their answer.

**Answering Mechanics**

- H. The ten(10) second time limit for the easy round and fifteen(15) second for the average, difficult and clincher rounds will begin with the word "go" by the Quizmaster.
- I. The contestant shall bring pens for writing except bond paper which will be provided by the management.
- J. Should a participant wish to change an answer that he/she has written down, this answer should be crossed out with one horizontal line. The new answer must be written clearly above the crossed out answer. A participant is allowed to change his/her answer within the time allotted for a particular question.
- K. Before a question is read, the contestant must raise their pens.
- L. After the time limit and the buzzer sounds, the contestant must stop writing and raise their pens immediately. Proctors will collect the answer sheets and the Board of Judges will check the answer.
- M. There will be four(4) rounds: Easy, Average, Difficult and Clincher. The clincher round takes place only if there is a tie.
- N. In Easy round, six (6) questions will be asked, in the Average round, seven (7) questions, in the difficult round, seven(7)questions, and in the Clincher round, as many questions as needed.
- O. For multiple choice questions, the contestants shall write the capital letter of their selected answer.
- P. For identification, fill in the blank and enumeration questions, the contestants shall write the words asked for.
- Q. Answers that are incorrectly spelled are considered wrong.

**Scoring Mechanics**

- R. The contest shall follow a point system of scoring:
 

Easy Round	-	1 point
Average Round	-	2 points
Difficult Round	-	3 points
Clincher Round	-	5 points

- S. At the end of each round, the cumulative score of each participant shall be computed and announced by the quizmaster.
- T. At the end of the contest, the contestant with the highest cumulative score shall be declared the Champion. The next three highest scoring contestants shall be declared First, Second, Third, and Fourth Runners-up, respectively.

#### **Tie Breaking Mechanics**

- U. In case of ties, the clincher questions shall be asked.
- V. Clincher questions shall be identification-type, taken from the difficult questions.
- W. Contestants are given 15 seconds to answer the clincher question.
- X. The winner shall be determined on a first-to score basis.

#### **Protest Mechanics**

- Y. The duly registered teacher-coach of the contestant is the only person authorized to make a protest.
- Z. All protests should be referred to the Board of Judges immediately, before the Quizmaster reads the next question.
- a. The Board of Judges shall be in complete control of the contest. Their decision shall be final in all questions/protests.
