**2018 DIVISION SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE**

**To: Education Program Supervisors/Coordinator  
Public Schools District Supervisors  
Principals In-Charge of the District  
Head Teacher In-Charge of the District  
Public and Private Elementary, Secondary and Integrated  
School Heads**

1. This is to inform the field that this Division will conduct the 2018 Division Schools Press Conference on September 29-30, 2018 per Section 1, Rule 2 of RA 7079, also known as the Campus Journalism Act of 1991.
2. The conference aims to:
  - a. promote understanding among campus journalists/participants the importance of journalism by expressing it through different journalistic endeavors;
  - b. provide a venue for an enriching learning experience for pupils and students in pursuing journalism as a career;
  - c. promote responsible and ethical journalism; and
  - d. enhance journalistic competence through healthy and friendly competitions.
3. The following are the contest venues:



4. The participants to these contests may come from 19 Districts comprising the school winners/qualifiers/members of school publication editorial board and must pre-register on or before September 25, 2018 at Division Office's Cashier Unit.

5. The following are the contests categories, to wit:
  - a. News Writing and Pagsulat ng Balita
  - b. Editorial Writing and Pagsulat ng Pangulong Tudling
  - c. Feature Writing and Pagsulat ng Lathalain
  - d. Sports Writing and Pagsulat ng Balitang Pampalakasan
  - e. Copy Reading and Headline Writing and Pagwawasto ng Sipi at Pag-uulo ng Balita
  - f. Science and Technology Writing and Pagsulat ng Pang-agham at Pangteknolohiyang Balita
  - g. Editorial Cartooning and Kartung Pang-Editorial
  - h. Column Writing and Pagsulat ng Kolum
  - i. Photojournalism and Larawang Pampahayagan (Any point and shoot camera with a maximum of 21 mega pixels will be required; no DSLR camera will be allowed. Contestants should also provide their own laptops, camera cable for the transfer of their photos and encoding of their captions).
  - j. Radio Broadcast and Scriptwriting (English and Filipino) – elementary and secondary levels.
  - k. TV Newscast and Scriptwriting (English and Filipino) – Elementary and secondary level (it should be clear that TV Newscast for Elementary has no higher level competition. However, participation of all schools is still encouraged.
6. Only ONE pupil/student journalist per participating school will be allowed to participate in every individual writing contests in the same medium; likewise for Radio Broadcast, only ONE (1) team composed of seven (7) participants shall be allowed to participate in every medium.
7. It is also understood that all the cameras, gadgets, extension cords, laptops and other needed equipment needed for photojournalism and radio broadcast will be provided by participating contestant/teams.
8. A registration fee of Two Hundred Fifty Pesos (250.00) shall be charged each participant to cover sounds, certificates, medals, trophies, foods for judges/facilitators and other related expenses chargeable against school MOOE/local funds and school paper/campus journalism funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
9. Participating schools are enjoined to submit two (2) copies of their school papers on the last school year's issue or this school year's first quarter issue.
10. Service Credits/Compensatory time-off will be earned by participating public school teachers/advisers and other Division Personnel on their services during Saturdays and Sundays per DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003.
