**2018 DIVISION "TORNEO DE HISTORIA" IN LOCAL HISTORY, PHILIPPINE HISTORY,
ASIAN HISTORY AND WORLD HISTORY**

1. Studying history as a discipline allows us to see beyond textbooks the past through new lenses and may gain valuable perspectives on the problems of our modern society, anent to this, this Office through the **Curriculum Implementation Division** will spearhead the conduct of the **Division "Torneo de Historia" in Local History and Philippine History** on **Tuesday, November 13, 2018 at 8 o'clock in the morning** at the **Kalibo Pilot Elementary School DLRC, Kalibo, Aklan**. Likewise, **Asian History** and **World History Quiz Bee** will be held at **1 o'clock in the afternoon** on the same date and venue.

2. The participants to the **Local History and Philippine History Quiz Bee** are the **three (3) winners** in the **district level** from either grade four, grade five or grade six. **One (1) grade seven** student per public/private secondary school will participate in the **Asian History Quiz** and **one (1) grade eight** student per public/private secondary school for the **World History Quiz**.

3. **Filipino** will be used as the official language in the conduct of **Local and Philippine History Quiz Bee** and **English** will be used for the **Asian History and World History Quiz**.

4. A registration fee of **fifty pesos** (Php 50.00) per contestant and coach will be collected to defray all the expenses for the said activities. The registration and other travelling expenses are chargeable against local/school funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

4. The **Division winners** in the **Philippine History Quiz Bee** will compete in the **Regional Level** tentatively scheduled **on December 2018** in Iloilo City, specific venue will be announced later.

5. The Quiz Bee mechanics, board of judges and committee workers are found in the enclosures.

6. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is earnestly desired.

DIVISION QUIZ BEE MECHANICS

A. General Mechanics

- a. The pupil/student-contestants shall wear their complete school uniform (with identification card) during the contest.
- b. The contestant's personal belongings such as bags, cellphones, tablet PCs, and writing and information materials shall be left in a designated area in the venue/to the coach during the course of the contest.
- c. The coaches of the students are advised to occupy the designated place at the venue. During the course of the contest, private communications between or among students and their respective coaches and/or their supporters are not allowed.
- d. The results of the contest as proclaimed by the Board of Judges will be final and executory.
- e. Winners shall be awarded medal and certificate right after the contest.

B. Reading Mechanics

- a. Each question will be read twice by the Quizmaster in Filipino for the elementary and in English for secondary.
- b. After the second reading, the Quizmaster shall say the word "go", only then the contestants will be allowed to write their answer.

C. Answering Mechanics

- a. The ten(10) second time limit for the easy round and fifteen(15) second for the average, difficult and clincher rounds will begin with the word "go" by the Quizmaster.
- b. The contestant shall bring pens for writing except bond paper which will be provided by the management.
- c. Should a participant wish to change an answer that he/she has written down, this answer should be crossed out with one horizontal line. The new answer must be written clearly above the crossed out answer. A participant is allowed to change his/her answer within the time allotted for a particular question.
- d. Before a question is read, the contestant must raise their pens.
- e. After the time limit and the buzzer sounds, the contestant must stop writing and raise their pens immediately. Proctors will collect the answer sheets and the Board of Judges will check the answer.
- f. There will be four(4) rounds: Easy, Average, Difficult and Clincher. The clincher round takes place only if there is a tie.
- g. Participants shall be given a total number of twenty (20) questions of which six(6) are easy, seven (7) are average and seven (7) are difficult.
- h. For multiple choice questions, the contestants shall write the capital letter of their selected answer.
- i. For identification, fill in the blank and enumeration questions, the contestants shall write the words asked for.
- j. Answers that are incorrectly spelled are considered wrong.

D. Scoring Mechanics

- a. The contest shall follow a point system of scoring:

Easy Round	-	1 point
Average Round	-	2 points
Difficult Round	-	3 points
Clincher Round	-	5 points

- b. At the end of each round, the cumulative score of each participant shall be computed and announced by the quizmaster.
- c. The contestant with the highest cumulative score shall be declared the Champion. The next three highest scoring contestants shall be declared First, Second and Third Runners-up, respectively.

E. Tie Breaking Mechanics

- a. In case of ties, the clincher questions shall be asked.
- b. Clincher questions shall be identification-type
- b. Contestants are given 15 seconds to answer the question.
- c. The winner shall be determined on a first-to score basis.

F. Protest Mechanics

- a. The duly registered teacher-coach of the contestant is the only person authorized to make a protest.
- b. All protests should be referred to the Board of Judges immediately, before the Quizmaster reads the next question. The protest or inquiry shall be addressed orally to the chair of the Board of Judges who shall recognize the protest or inquiry after validating the proof/evidence presented
- c. Only the teacher-coach will act as the Official Chaperon/Guardian of the contestant to the Regional History Quiz Bee.
- d. The Board of Judges shall be in complete control of the contest. Their decision shall be final in all questions/protests.
