## 2018 GLOBAL HANDWASHING DAY CELEBRATION

To: Schools Division Superintendents **Division SBM-WinS Coordinators** School Heads. Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

- 1. Pursuant to the United Nation's (UN) declaration of a Global Handwashing Day (every October 15th) and Philippine House of Representatives Resolution No. 1436 otherwise known as the "Implementation of Annual Global Handwashing Day", the 2018 Global Handwashing Day (GHD) shall be celebrated by all schools in Region VI on October 15, 2018
- 2. Global Handwashing Day is an annual global advocacy day dedicated to increasing awareness and understanding about the importance of handwashing with soap and water as an easy, effective, and affordable way to prevent diseases and save lives. This year's theme, "Clean hands - a recipe for health" focuses on the links between handwashing and food including food hygiene and nutrition. This reminds us to make handwashing a part of every meal and an important part of keeping food safe, preventing diseases, and helping children grow strong.
- 3. To highlight this year's Global Handwashing Day Celebration, all schools all throughout Region VI are enjoined to participate in a 10-minute Synchronized Handwashing Activity starting at exactly 9:30 in the morning on October 15, 2018.
- 4. Global Handwashing Day is likewise an opportunity to design, test, and replicate creative ways to encourage people to wash their hands with soap and water at critical times, thus, schools and Schools Divisions are encouraged to innovate activities in order to make the celebration more meaningful to learners, teachers, parents and the community.
- 5. The Regional Office will once again award the Schools Divisions with remarkable and creative ways of celebrating the Global Handwashing Day. Mechanics for this year's GHD Best Celebration will be disclosed in a separate memorandum.
- 6. A division consolidated narrative reports with pictorials on the Global Hand-washing Day celebration shall be submitted to the Regional Office through the Regional School-Based Management - WaSH in Schools (SBM-WinS) Coordinator not later than 30 days after the celebration.
