

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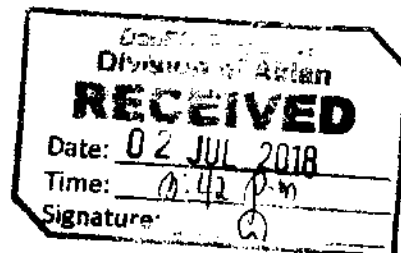

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II. QUALIFICATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

1. Only members of affiliated clubs, gyms and schools that are in good standing with the Philippine Taekwondo Association may join the competition.
2. Contestants shall represent their affiliated club, gym or school.
3. Age requirements:
 - a. **Senior Division:** players who are 18 years old and above
 - b. **Junior Division:** players who are 15-17 years old
 - c. **Cadet Division:** players who are 12-14 years old
 - d. **Children's Division:** players who are 11 years old and below

III. REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

1. ALL CONTESTANTS MUST PRESENT THEIR 2018 *NCC (NATIONAL COMPETITORS CARD) UPON REGISTRATION. Application for NCC – P500.
**This plastic laminated ID Card is valid for one (1) year to be used in all PTA events starting this year (2017).*
2. Only Official Competition Forms provided in the ground rules will be accepted.
3. Instructors must submit a Master list of Players.
4. All participants must submit a duly accomplished Registration Form and Waiver.
5. Contestants in the Children and Junior's Division must submit a clear copy of proof of age (birth certificate, baptismal certificate and passport) or present their NCC.
6. A Registration Fee of P500.00 is required upon registration.

IV. WEIGH-IN

1. Deputized Weigh-in Officials: Only Deputized Weigh-in Officials are allowed to weigh-in participants for all PTA organized competitions. All documents shall be properly stamped or signed by the deputized weigh-in official and shall be accepted as final (no verification required).
2. Weighing Scales and Height Measurement Guide: Only official calibrated weighing scales and height measurement guides shall be used for all weigh-in. (All weighing scales must be calibrated prior to weigh-in)
3. Weigh-in Attire: The players' attire during weigh-in shall be shirt with shorts, jogging pants or dobok pants. Footwear, socks, and jewelry shall be removed prior to weigh-in.

4. Pre-Weigh-in. The organizing committee shall provide a pre weigh-in set-up at the official weigh-in venue where the players can check their weight prior to final weigh-in.
5. Final weigh-in:
 - a. Where there is a pre-weigh-in set-up, players may only weigh-in once for the final weigh-in. In the absence of a pre weigh-in set-up, players will be given only two chances to weigh-in.
 - b. OFFICIAL WEIGHT AND HEIGHT LIMITS WILL BE STRICTLY FOLLOWED. NO ALLOWANCE WILL BE GIVEN.
6. Fighting Weight of Competitors: For all PTA organized competitions, a player must compete in the weight category registered in the final weigh-in.

VI. METHOD OF COMPETITION

1. The competition shall be individual, single elimination.
2. Matches of Novice Grade School, Junior and Senior Divisions and Advance Grade School Division from eliminations to finals shall be 2 rounds of 1.5 minutes per round with 30 seconds interval between rounds.
3. Matches of Advance Junior and Senior Divisions from eliminations to quarter-finals shall be 2 rounds of 1.5 minutes per round with 30 seconds interval between rounds.
4. Matches of Advance Junior and Senior Divisions from semi-finals to finals shall be 3 rounds of 2 minutes per round with 30 seconds interval between rounds.
5. In case more than one player of a chapter are in the same category, these players will not meet in the first match unless a "bye" is drawn by one player (a "bye" is considered a match win).
6. In case there are less than 4 participants in a category, this category may be merged with adjacent categories.
7. Each Division shall have a Novice and Advance categories.
 - a. Novice: Yellowbelt & Bluebelts (see Novice Division Guidelines Below)
 - b. Advance: Redbelt, Brownbelt & Blackbelt
8. All players fighting in the Advance Division (red, brown, yellow or blue) should wear the BLUE/BLACKBELT (New Competition belt for advance players)

NOVICE DIVISION GUIDELINES:

It is the spirit of the Novice Division to provide an opportunity for beginners to compete with other players with the same skill level. It is therefore against the spirit of this provision to have players who have stayed long in Yellowbelt or Bluebelt; or who have developed skills equivalent to Redbelt or higher to join in the Novice Division. Instructors and coaches are therefore reminded to use their discretion in fielding players in the Novice Division.

- a. Who are excluded: The following should compete in the advanced division:
 1. Players who are more than 8 months from the date of their promo test as whitebelt.
 2. Players who have won a gold or silver in previous national, island group and regional or national competitions.
 3. Players who have developed advanced skills (power, speed and technique)
 4. Members of school varsity teams, school or LGU selection.
- b. Sanctions:
 1. Players found to have violated this provision shall be suspended from participating in any PTA organized competitions for one (1) year.
 2. The instructor, along with all the chapter he handles, will likewise be suspended from participation in PTA competitions and will be barred from taking the promotion test for a minimum of one (1) year or shall pay a fine of Php 10,000.00
 3. The instructor shall also issue a letter of explanation and apology addressed to the Chief Instructor, PTA.

VII. SCORING SYSTEM

1. ***Protector Scoring System (PSS) will be used in the Advanced Categories and Electronic Scoring System (ESS) will be used in the Novice Categories during the tournament.**
*Advance players must provide their own sensing socks.
2. The following scoring system shall be observed:
 - a. Body kick – 2 points
 - b. Turning kick to the body – 3 points
 - c. Head kick – 3 points
 - d. Turning kick to the head – 4 points
3. The 12-point gap during the second round will be observed during the semi-final and final rounds only. For the elimination rounds the 20 point gap rule will be observed.

VIII. PROTESTS

1. Protests regarding match results shall be made in writing using the Protest Form. A protest fee of Php 1,000.00 is required.
2. The protest shall be submitted to the Tournament Manager not later than 30 minutes after the match in question.
3. If the Arbitration Committee decides in favor of the protesting party, the protest fee shall be refunded.
4. A written protest and protest fee shall not be required in the following cases and shall be resolved with the Tournament Manager:
 - questions about a player's affiliation or good standing with the PTA;
 - questions about a player's qualifications (age, height or weight)

IX. AWARDS

Medals shall be awarded to the winners of each category

First Place	: gold medal
Second Place	: silver medal
Third Place (2)	: bronze medal

X. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. **Competition Codes of Conduct:** The PTA Competition Codes of Conduct shall be strictly enforced.
2. **Year 2016 Resolutions:** Resolutions made by the PTA Tournament Directors during the 2016 conference on competition management shall be enforced.
3. **Competition Rules:** For all other matters not provided for in these ground rules, the latest WTF Competition Rules and Interpretation shall apply.
4. **Competition Uniform:** The contestant shall use only the approved Taekwondo competition uniform (dobok) with the PTA or WTF approved seal.

NOTE: Use of the "PHILIPPINES" print on the uniform is reserved for members of the National Taekwondo Team and for those who have represented the country in international competitions. Otherwise, such usage is strictly prohibited.

5. **Competition Equipment:** Only brands approved by the PTA and/or WTF shall be approved for use. The contestants shall provide their own competition equipment (head protector, body protector, arm & shin guards, groin guard, & hand gloves).
6. **Mouth Guard:** The use of the mouth guard shall be required. *For the children's division*, the mouth guard shall be required for heights of over 128 cm.
7. **Coaches' Attire:** Coaches are required to wear **collared shirt** and pants. No slippers or sandals, caps, sleeveless shirts will be allowed.
8. **TBB / TBS:** Participating TBB / TBS shall compete in the senior division.

9. **Referees:** Only National and Regional Referees who have passed the course for the current rules shall serve during the competition. They shall serve full-time.
