### 2019 - 2020 REGIONAL FESTIVAL OF TALENTS

1. The Department of Education Region VI through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division will conduct the **2019 - 2020 Regional Festival of Talents (RFOT)** with the theme **Authentic Filipino Talents and Skills: Breaking the Barriers in Inclusive Education Towards Unity in Diversity**

2. The **2019 - 2020 RFOT** aims to:

- provide opportunity for learners from public or private elementary and secondary schools, as well as learners from the Alternative Learning System (ALS), Indigenous People Education (IPED), Special Education (SPED), and Madrasah / Muslim Education Program (MEP) to showcase their talents and skills through exhibition of their products, services and performances;
- provide opportunity for participants to explore the cultures of the other division, and
- showcase talents and skills in the following areas:
  - *Technolympics* for Technology and Livelihood Education and Technical Vocational-Livelihood;
  - *Sining Tanghalan* for Music and Arts;
  - Special Program in Foreign Language;
  - Musabaqah for ALIVE/MEP;
  - Sign Language and Braille Reading and writing for learners with VI and HI;
  - National Population Development for Social Studies (*Araling Panlipunan*);
  - *Pambansang Tagisan ng Talino* for Filipino; and
  - Science Processes and Practices On-Site Test for Science, Technology and Mathematics.

3. The Regional Festival of Talent shall be conducted on the following schedules and venues with the corresponding registration fee to cover expenses relative to the activity.


