2019 DIVISION FESTIVAL OF TALENTS ON POPDEV IN ARALING PANLIPUNAN

- 1. In connection with the forthcoming conduct of Regional Festival of Talents on PopDev in Araling Panlipunan, this Office through the Curriculum Implementation Division will spearhead the conduct of the different contests on PopDev to identify our regional contestants. The contests to be competed are as follows; Population Quiz, Population Debate, Jingle Writing and Singing and On-the-Spot Poster Making on Saturday, October 26, 2019 at 8:00 o'clock in the morning at the Kalibo Pilot Elementary School DLRC, Kalibo, Aklan. This year's theme is "Authentic Filipino Talents and Skills: Breaking the Barriers in Inclusive Education Towards Unity in Diversity."
- 2. The following are the activities:

- 3. The Population Quiz, Debate, Poster Making and Jingle-Writing and Singing on PopDev aims to:
 - a. convey the population and the development concepts and messages to the youth;
 - b. make the learners become responsible and productive members of the community; and
 - c. provide opportunities for elementary and secondary learners to showcase their talents and learning in Social Studies through an exhibition of their skills and performance.
- 4. The contestants are the following:
 - a. Pop Ed Quiz one (1) contestant from each public and private Junior/Senior High School.
 - b. PopDev Debate one (1) contestant from each district(Junior/Senior High School)
 - c. Poster Making Contest one (1) grade 4-6 contestant from each district public/private elementary school.
 - d. Jingle Writing and Singing Contest- one (1) district champion/representative from public / private Junior/Senior High School.

- A registration fee of fifty pesos (Php 50.00) per contestant and coach will be collected to defray the incidental expenses for the said activities. Travel expenses and registration fee of participants shall be charged against local/school funds or other allowable sources subject to the accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- The champion in the different PopDev Competitions will represent the division in the 2019 Regional Festival of Talents on PopDev in Araling Panlipunan slated on November 8-10, 2019 at Negros Occidental High School, Bacolod City.
- The board of judges, committee workers and contest mechanics are found in the enclosures.
- Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is earnestly desired. 8.

A. EVENT PACKAGE

 POP DEV DEBATE- the event is a combination of argumentation and debate that is conducted in a modified round table discussion. It enables the contestant to use his/her critical analysis and deep reasoning about the different issues that occur in the society. This also develops the ability of the students to organize his/her ideas promptly and logically.

Criteria:

Delivery

(tone of voice, use of gestures and level of enthusiasm are convincing to others) - 20%

Use of Supporting Evidence

(examples and facts to support reason with references)

Organization

25%

(view points and responses are outlined both clearly and orderly) - 25%

Reasoning & Ability to Answer

(reasons are given to support viewpoints, arguments made by the other are responded to and dealt with effectively)

Rules and Mechanics:

- There shall be only **one** (1) contestant/debater from each district public/private Junior/Senior High School. The debater shall be accompanied and trained by the duly approved coach.
- 2. Each contestant shall wear a **corporate attire**. Moreover they are required to present their **valid school ID** during the registration.
- Contestant shall be assigned a number that will correspond to the number on the judging sheet.
- 4. Topics to be debated shall revolve on the following issues; foreign and economic policies, environment, gender and society, governance, peace and order, population and reproductive health and other current/contemporary issues.
- The debater is required to use the English language as a medium except for terminologies on certain topics that are only stated in Filipino.
- 6. The debate will consist of two (2) rounds.

Round 1: Elimination Round

- 1. Each debater will be given a maximum of three (3) minutes to deliver his/her speech on the topic drawn.
- 2. After the discourse of the first contestant /debater, the second debater will interpolate on the speech of the first debater. The questions for the interpolation will be focused on the arguments of the opponent. Categorical questions will be allowed (answerable by yes or no), however, the responder may choose to qualify or not his/her answer. The first interpolator and the debater will be given a maximum of three (3) minutes and if ever the interpolator did not consume the allotted time, remaining time shall be added to the next interpolator. The remaining interpolators will be given two (2) minutes. In the case that the remaining interpolator will not

- consume the two (2) minutes allotted, the first interpolator may use the remaining minutes of the five (5) minutes allotted.
- 3. The second contestant will also give his/her speech on the topic, the third debater will be asking questions to debater 2, debater 3 will be asked by debater 4, debater 4 by debater 5, debated 5 by debater 6 and so on.

Round 2: Final Round

- After the first round, eight (8) debaters will be chosen to proceed on the second round. The debaters will be following the same order as of the first round.
- 5. A new topic for debate will be given on the second round. The topics will also be selected from the issues enumerated previously during the first round.
- 6. The same process from round 1 (no.3)shall be followed.
- 7. Prompting and coaching during the duration of the debate shall be strictly prohibited.
- POPDEV QUIZ- questions will be based on the following Population Education Core Messages/Key Concepts; Family Life and Responsible Parenthood, Gender and Development, Population and Reproductive Health, Population, Environment, Resources and Sustainable Development.

Rules & Mechanics

- The student contestants shall wear their complete school uniform with identification card during the contest.
- 2. During the quiz, participants shall bring pens, answer sheets will be provided by the management.
- 3. **English** or Filipino will be used as official language in the conduct of the quiz.
- Participants will be given a total number of 20 questions, of which six (6) are easy, seven(7) are average and seven (7) are difficult.
- 5. Points for every correct answer will be be given as follows; easy round-1 point, average round-2 points, difficult round-3 points and clincher round-5 points.
- Participants shall be given ten seconds to answer each question. For questions that require computation, participants shall be given a maximum of thirty seconds to answer.
- 7. The quizmaster will read each question twice.
 Countdown will start after the question has been read
 the second time, and the quizmaster says GO. When the
 quizmaster says STOP or TIME IS UP, contestants must raise
 their pens immediately. Proctors will correct the answer
 sheets and the Board of Judges will check the answer. At
 the end of each round, the cumulative score of each
 participant shall be computed and announce by the
 quiz master. Division winners will be proclaimed based on
 cumulative scoring
- 8. In case of a tie, a clincher question drawn from difficult category shall be asked until a winner emerges.
- In case of a protest or inquiry during the actual quiz proceedings, the following procedures shall be observed;
 - Only the contestant or the official coach of the participant is allowed to raise a protest or inquiry before the next question is read. The protest or inquiry will be addressed orally to the

- chair of the board of judges who will recognize the protest or inquiry.
- The chair will announce the decision upon deliberation with the members of the board of judges.
- 10. The results of the contest as proclaimed by the Board of Judges will be final and executory.
- JINGLE WRITING & SINGING CONTEST this contest is open to Junior or Senior High student, the contestant will wear t shirt and jeans during the contest.

Event Rules & Mechanics

- a. The **theme** of the showcase will be announced on the **actual day** of the skills exhibition
- **b.** The **jingle** must be an original composition highlighting the theme. **Lyrics** must be in **English**.
- c. Participants shall be given **one** (1) hour **to compose** and **thirty minutes** to **practice** their composition in a holding room.
- d. The **order of the presentation** shall be determined through **draw lots**. This will be done during the registration.
- e. The contestants are **not allowed to introduce** themselves but as their number be called they shall immediately perform.
- f. Participants will be given a maximum of three minutes to perform in acapella.
- ON THE SPOT POSTER MAKING- this contest will be participated by grade 4-6 pupils.

Event Rules & Mechanics

- a. The contestant shall draw their numbers during registration. They will be given a number tag which will be attached to the poster.
- b. The **theme of the showcase** will be announced on the **actual day** of the skills exhibition. Any artwork in the poster must be original.
- c. The contestant shall be **provided with 1/8 illustration board** except the coloring materials to be used in the skills exhibition.
- d. Participants shall be given one(1) hour to finish their artwork.
