2019 DIVISION TECHNOLYMPICS

- 1. The Department of Education, Division of Aklan, in collaboration with the Regional Association of Technology and Livelihood Educators (RATLE) VI Aklan Chapter, will conduct the **2019 Division Technolympics** with the theme "Authentic Filipino Talents and Skills: Breaking the Barriers in Inclusive Education Towards Unity in Diversity." The Elementary Level will be held on November 5-6, 2019 at Altavas Elementary School, Altavas, Aklan and the Secondary Level will be held on November 8-9, 2019 at Aklan National High School for Arts and Trades, Andagao, Kalibo, Aklan.
- 2. The objective of this activity is to provide opportunities for pupils and students to showcase their talents and learning in Edukasyong Pantahanan at Pangkabuhayan (EPP), Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE) and Technical Vocational Education (TVE) through an exhibition of their products and performances.
- 3. This activity is participated in by the first place winners in the district level/school level contest, district supervisors, school heads, TLE/TVE department heads, EPP/TLE coordinators, teachers, coaches and learners.
- 4. A registration fee of one hundred fifty pesos (Php 150.00) will be charged to each student participant and two hundred pesos (Php 200.00) for adult participant to defray expenses for honoraria of the board of judges, certificates, medals and other expenses relevant to the conduct of this activity.
- 5. The registration fee, travel expenses, per diems and other incidental expenses relative to the attendance to this activity are chargeable against STEP funds, canteen fund and other sources of funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 6. To determine the exact number of participants to be accommodated by the host schools, the EPP/TLE/TVE coordinators are advised to register their participants on or before October 30, 2019 for Elementary Level and before November 4, 2019 for Secondary Level. Attention: Mrs. Marivic I. Tolentino, Education Program Supervisor, In-charge of this activity.

- 7. The contestants are required to wear white T-shirt and maong pants during the opening program and contest proper. Coaches, however, shall wear their district uniform. District coordinators are requested to bring their district banners.

- 1. The participants of the 2019 Division Technolympics will showcase their best products, services and performances in the different events as evidence of their learning in the EPP/TLE/TVE.
- 2. The participants are winners in the school-based/district competitions and are currently enrolled in the public elementary, junior, senior high schools and Alternative Learning System (ALS) for SY 2019-2020.
- 3. Contestants in the secondary level should be enrolled in/passed the specialization aligned with the contest category.
- 4. Only one entry per district shall be accepted in Bread and Pastry Production (BPP), Experimental Cookery and Table Skirting with Certer Piece.
- 5. For other skills contests, there will be a maximum of nineteen (19) entries.
- 6. The contestants will bring all the tools, equipment and materials needed for the contest as agreed during the meeting of EPP/TLE/TVE coordinators.
- 7. Implementing guidelines on the conduct of the 2019 Division Technolympics shall be based on DepEd Memorandum No. 168, s. 2018 entitled "2019 National Festival of Talents."
- 8. All clarifications, issues and concerns relative to the Division Technolympics shall be addressed during the orientation after the opening program.
