 To inform the conduct of the Aklan Council, BSP the Council Level Selection for the 2019 SEARCH FOR THE TEN OUTSTANDING BOY SCOUTS OF THE PHILIPPINES, RE: National Office Memorandum No. 41 s.2019.

- The purpose of the search is to give due recognition to our Scouts who best epitomize good moral character, have maintained academic excellence and demonstrated sterling qualities of leadership in the institution and community.
- The search is open to currently registered Senior Scouts who are Filipino citizens, at least 15 to 17 years old, holder of Venturer or Eagle Scout Rank and have not reached 18 years old at the time of nomination to the Local Council Level Search.

- 5. The top 2 candidates shall be declared as winner and shall represent the Council to the Regional Level Selection.
- 6. A cash prize of P 5,000.00 each and a certificate of recognition will be given to the 2 winners (Council Level). Plaques and medallions and cash prize of P 10,000.00 each will be awarded to the regional winners. The Local Councils and the Schools represented by the Regional winners will likewise be given each Plaque of Recognition. The National winners of the Ten Outstanding Boy Scouts of the Philippines for 2019 will receive trophies, medals and cash prize of P 25,000.00 each.
- The uniform criteria for the selection in the Council, Regional and National Search are as follows:

 - Contents won and participated in from the school to International/National/Regional/Division level indicating the honors/distinctions received
- A.4 School-based Leadership and Activities spearhead/participated in
 - Positions in school-based co-/extra-curricular organizations
 - School-based activities organized indicating the level (International/National/Regional/Division/School)

- School-based activities participated in indicating the level (International/National/Regional/Division/School)
- A.5 Community-based Leadership and Activities spearhead/participated in
 - Positions in community-based organization other than the BSP
 - Community-based activities organized indicating the level (International/National/Regional/Division/School)
 - Community-based activities participated in indicating the level (International/National/Regional/Division/School)
 - Awards and commendations received

A.6 Church-based Activities

- Positions in church-based organizations
- Involvement in church based activities as certified by the Parish Priest/official concerned
