Annex D of DepEd Memorandum No. 036, s. 2019, under Wash in Schools, No. 12 is retained with the note that *Brigada Eskwela* 2020 includes the old normal until March 16, 2020 when the pandemic was officially announced as a National State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines due to Corona Virus Disease per Proclamation No. 922, s. 2020.
