2. Parent Volunteers (5%)

Parent Volunteer Turnout

Target Parent Volunteer Participation* x 5%

*The Target Parent Volunteer Participation is up to 200% of the learners' population.

- 3. Other Volunteers (5%)
 - a. NGAs and other government organizations and public corporations (1%)
 - b. LGUs (barangay, municipal, provincial) (1%)
 - c. Community involvement including NGOs and professional associations (1%)
 - d. Private sector involvement including corporate foundations (1%)
 - e. Pupil / student organizations (SSG / SPG), alumni associations and other civic organizations / associations (1%)
