

SUBJECT : 61st JAMBOREE-ON-THE-AIR (JOTA) &
22nd JAMBOREE-ON-THE-INTERNET (JOTI)

1. The 61st Jamboree-On-The-Air (JOTA) and the 22nd Jamboree-On-The-Internet (JOTI) is held every year on the 3rd week of October. This year this will be conducted on October 19 - 21, 2018 at BSP National Office, 181 Natividad Almeda-Lopez St., Ermita, Manila with a satellite located at the Philippine International Convention Center (PICC). The traditional timeframe is Saturday 00:00 H until Sunday 24:00 H local time. Each station can choose its own operating hours, beginning on Friday at 00:00 H, based on their local telecommunication regulations and authorization, as well as station and Scout availability.
2. The theme of the event is **“Life on Land – United Nations Sustainable Development Goal 15”**. The theme encourages reaching out to Scouts and Guides all over the world and engage in conversations with each other by means of amateur radio and the Internet about Scouting program.
3. The Aklan Council, BSP will participate in the above stated International Scouting event starting on October 19, 2018 at 6:00 P.M until October 21, 2018 at 10:00 A.M. at BSP, Aklan Council Headquarters.
4. This activity is one of the requirements on World Brotherhood Merit Badge for the Advancement rank of **Senior Scouts**. Other scout activities will be conducted for the duration of the JOTA to enable Scouts to earn additional Merit Badges.
5. All participants should have their own personal computer (laptop) and personal pocket Wi-Fi.
6. **No registration fee.** Scouts and Scouters will be responsible for their transportation and food provisions for the duration of the activity.
7. It is suggested that only handy equipment (uniform, dome tent, sleeping gears, extra clothes, personal kit, etc.) should be brought.
8. Transportation and other incidental expenses of Teachers/Scouters are chargeable against local funds, subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
9. Service Credits will be granted for the services rendered on Saturday and Sunday.
10. Full support, cooperation and immediate dissemination of this memorandum are desired.
