**SUBJECT : 62nd JAMBOREE-ON-THE-AIR (JOTA) &
23rd JAMBOREE-ON-THE-INTERNET (JOTI)**

1. The Aklan Council, Boy Scouts of the Philippines will participate in the 62nd Jamboree-on-the-Air (JOTA) and 23rd Jamboree-on-the-Internet (JOTI), held every year on the 3rd week of October, this year per BSP National Office Memo No. 57, s. 2019, will be conducted on October 18 – 20, 2019. See attached Memorandum.
2. Aklan Council, BSP will conduct the International Scouting Event starting **October 18, 2019 at 6:00 P.M. until October 20, 2019 at 10:00 A.M., at the Aklan Council BSP, Headquarters, Kalibo, Aklan.**
3. This activity is one of the requirements on World Brotherhood Merit Badge for the Advancement of **Senior Scouts**. Other scout activities will be conducted for the duration of the JOTA to enable Scouts to earn additional Merit Badges.
4. All participants should have their own personal computer (laptop) and personal pocket Wi-Fi.
5. **No registration fee.** Scouts and Scouters will be responsible for their transportation and food provisions for the duration of the activity.
6. It is suggested that only handy equipment (uniform, dome tent, sleeping gears, extra clothes, personal kit, etc.) should be brought.
7. Transportation and other incidental expenses of Teachers/Scouters are chargeable against local funds, subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
8. It is understood that in the conduct of this activity, as stated in DO No. 66, s. 2017, all must follow the following:
 - a. Ensure relevance and alignment with the educational competencies of the K to 12 Curriculum and leadership development of learners;
 - b. Uphold child protection principles and that no learner shall be disadvantaged in any form; and
 - c. Observe the safety and security protocols for all participants before, during and after the activity.
9. Service Credits will be granted for the services rendered on Saturday and Sunday.
10. Full support, cooperation and immediate dissemination of this memorandum are desired.

**SUBJECT : 62ND JAMBOREE-ON-THE-AIR (JOTA) and
23RD JAMBOREE-ON-THE-INTERNET (JOTI)**

1. The 62nd Jamboree-On-The-Air (JOTA) and the 23rd Jamboree-On-The-Internet (JOTI) will be held on third weekend of October 18-20, 2019 at BSP National Office, 15/F, 181 Natividad Almeda-Lopez St., Ermita, Manila. The traditional timeframe is Saturday 00:00H until Sunday 24:00H local time. Each station can choose its own operating hours, including beginning on Friday at 00:00H, based on their local telecommunications regulations and authorization, as well as station and Scout availability.
2. The Official Amateur Radio Club of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines is **DX1BSP** per approved National Executive Board Resolution No. 53-2017, Series of 2017. DX1BSP will be the one responsible for the conduct of the JOTA,
3. The theme of the event will be **"Life on Land — United Nations Sustainable Development Goal 15"**. The theme encourages reaching out to Scouts all over the world and engage in conversations with each other by means of amateur radio and the Internet in Scouting programs.
4. Hereunder is pertinent information of this event
62nd Jamboree-On-The-Air (JOTA) and the 23rd Jamboree-On-The-Internet (JOTI)

Guidelines for Participation:

- a. The participating Council with the Amateur Radio operator and/or club must register first at JOTA-JOTI WOSM website <https://www.jotajoti.info>.
- b. After the registration, the amateur radio club must send the following details to DX1BSP dx1bsp.nhq@gmail.com:
 1. School Name / Council Name
 2. Name of Amateur Radio Club
 3. Locations
 4. Valid Radio Station License
 5. The DX1BSP will send a confirmation of your registration including log sheet and report form.
- c. All stations must operate strictly in accordance with the Philippine Amateur Radio regulations.
- d. Call "CQ Jamboree" or answer any station that you may hear using this call.
- e. When you call or search for station/s, use any of the following frequencies:


- The opening and calling frequency for the JOTA will be at **7.090 MHz** will likewise be heard at **BSP TG 515032** and **YSF 51701 PH DX1BSP**.
- As in previous years, solicit the early assistance/support of the Amateur Radio Organizations/Associations in your locality.

23rd Jamboree-On-The-Internet (JOTI)

How to organize a Council JOTI Station:

- Local Councils should create a JOTI Station and select a Coordinator. The station shall be called "(Name of Council) JOTI Station," example: *Manila Council Internet Team*
- The Coordinator and the members of the group should have the following:
 - Knowledgeable on computer hardware and software specially in the use of Internet Browser (Internet Explorer or Netscape Navigator) and Chatting (mIRC or vIRC)
 - Must have a personal computer
 - Must have an access to the Internet that can be used for the JOTI.
 - Must have an e-mail address
- It is suggested that at least one (1) group/patrol/crew and one (1) trained Adult Leader be designated to operate a JOTI station.
- As soon as the Council JOTI station has been established, please submit to National Office, BSP the following information thru e-mail: bsp@scouts.org.ph
 - Local Council JOTI station Coordinator
 - Members of the group
 - Homepage or web site address
 - E-mail addresses of the members
 - List of Group/Troop/Patrol/Institutional JOTI station with e-mail address
 - Other Scouting activities simultaneous with event

5. It is suggested that Local Councils should conduct simultaneous Scout Activities (Camping, Forum, Better world programs, Solar Energy, etc.) during the 62nd Jamboree-On-The-Air (JOTA) and the 23rd Jamboree-On-The-Internet (JOTI) to enable the Scouts to earn additional Merit Badges.
