"7TH INTER-SCHOOL SCIENCE WIZARD TOURNAMENT"

- 1. The School of Veterinary Medicine of the Aklan State University will be having their 7th Inter-School Science Wizard Tournament on February 20, 2018 at the ASU Amphitheater, AKlan State University- Banga Campus, Banga, Aklan.
- 2. All integrated and secondary schools are invited to join the contest. In every school, two students (any grade level) and one official teacher coach could participate.
- 3. The contest will be composed of three rounds Easy, Average, and Difficult wherein there will be ten (10) questions per round. It will cover topics on Biology, Chemistry, and Physics.
- 4. A registration fee of **one hundred fifty pesos (Php150.00)** will be charged to all participating schools. Registration and travel expenses may be charged against local/school board/club funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 5. Immediate and wide dissemination of the content of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.
