**OBSERVANCE OF THE 2021 NATIONAL DISASTER RESILIENCE MONTH**

**To:** Schools Division Superintendents  
All Others Concerned

1. Executive Order No. 29, s. 2017 dated June 28, 2017 mandates the observance of the National Disaster Resilience Month (NDRM) throughout the country for the whole month of July of every year through the conduct of activities relative to building disaster resilience. This year's theme is "**Tamang Pamamahala't Kahandaan, Kaalaman at Pagtutulongan sa Sakuna at Pandemya'y Kalasag ng Bayan** (*Husto nga Pagdumala kag Pangaman, Ihibalo kag Pagbiniligay sation sang Kalalat-an kag Pandemya ang Taming sang Banwa*)", to emphasize the important role of disaster risk governance and the collaboration of all Filipinos to overcome the challenges of this pandemic and to rebuild resilient community.

2. In view of this, the Division Offices and Schools are encouraged to undertake relevant activities, with strict adherence to precautionary measures for COVID-19, *however*, they must not be limited to the following:

- a. display of streamers indicating this year's theme in offices and schools;
- b. conduct information dissemination on disaster consciousness and preparedness in coordination with local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office;
- c. discuss through online and other forms of communication like radio about risk reduction/mitigation and inculcate awareness of emerging infectious diseases, all hazards both man-made and natural;
- d. encourage the culture of preparedness;
- e. use the NDRM Facebook profile frame on respective Facebook accounts; and
- f. hold other related activities which will be done through online platform.

3. The NDRM observance reiterates the importance of understanding disaster risks, strengthening disaster risk governance, investing in disaster risk reduction for resilience, enhancing preparedness for effective response, and implementing "Build Back Better" in rehabilitation and recovery.
