1. This is to inform the field of the changes/modifications and additional guidelines for the upcoming 8<sup>th</sup> Division YES-O Congress.
2. The new schedule for **8<sup>th</sup> Division YES-O Congress - Elementary Level** will be on **March 8-10, 2018**. This was moved to avoid having conflict with the Regional YES-O Congress for Secondary Level which is scheduled on March 1-3, 2018.
3. Additional rules/contest mechanics for the different contests is attached as Enclosure No. 1. Members of the Executive and Working Committees and List of Teacher Facilitators are also attached as Enclosure No. 2. Detailed Matrix of Activities can be found as Enclosure No. 3.
4. Teacher participants, facilitators, Committee Chair and Members and support staff for the 8<sup>th</sup> Division YES-O Congress (Elementary and Secondary Level) will be given **service credits** on Saturdays as per DepED Order No. 53, s. 2003.
5. Immediate and wide dissemination of the content of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.

## ADDITIONAL RULES/ REVISIONS TO THE CONTEST MECHANICS OF SELECTED CONTEST CATEGORIES

- a. **TERRA-AQUARIUM MAKING** - The contestant shall provide the **two empty 6000 mL mineral water container** of the same brand and other materials. All materials must be brought by the contestants. Models which did not follow the correct concept will be disqualified. The model must show the link between the land and water. It must reveal the interdependence between the terra and the aquatic life. **Non-compliance to the concept may result to the disqualification of the entry.** The criteria for judging the outputs are as follows:
- Artistry/Creativity - 30%
  - Craftmanship/Sustainability - 20%
  - Harmony/Compliance to Science concept - 30%
  - Overall Impact - 20%
- b. **INTERPRETATIVE DANCE CONTEST** - There must be 6-8 members per group. The participating group may be all-boys, all-girls, or mixed. Performance must not exceed five (5) minutes including entrance and exit. Performer can use more than one music, and use of "Kapaligiran" song by Asin is required (as per regional YES-O mechanics). This can be mashed up with other songs. Performance must depict environmental awareness. **Only body props are to be used.** Music piece must be in audio-CD form and must be submitted to the contest committee before the contest. The criteria for judging the outputs are as follows:
- Master and Execution - 20%
  - Musically and effective use of body props - 20%
  - Interpretation - 40%
  - Concept - 20%
- c. **JINGLE FOR THE ENVIRONMENT CONTEST** - There must be 10-15 members per group. Performance must be 3 to 5 minutes only. But contestants are given not longer than 2 minutes to prepare. One point will be deducted in every 30 seconds of extension. Lyrics should be an original composition and in Filipino or English (but Filipino is preferred) but the melody could be of other original/popular songs. Vulgar or indecent words must not be used. Acapella is allowed or any musical instruments can be used as accompaniment at the composer's discretion but minus one is NOT ALLOWED. The theme must be about the environment (awareness, protection, conservation). Lyrics of the Jingle piece must be submitted to the contest facilitator in three (3) copies before the start of the contest. Instrumentalist are included as participants. Use of pyrotechnics is not allowed. Minimal props which are usually made of recycled / recyclable materials are allowed. Hand movements are allowed but there must be NO choreography. Contestants must wear their YES-O shirt (for regional level). The criteria for judging are as follows:
- Melody - 25%
  - Lyrical content - 40%
  - Harmony - 25%
  - Mastery - 10%

**d. YES-O RAP CONTEST** - There must be 2-4 members per group. Performance must NOT EXCEED 3 minutes. Content of the piece must be original and written in English or Filipino and strictly be about issues related to the environment (global warming, calamities, industrialization, pollution, etc). No musical instruments should be used. Participants must be composed of vocalist/s and beat boxer/s. Attire must be decent. Four copies of the lyrics must be submitted to the contest facilitator before the contest will start. The criteria for judging are as follows:

- Melody - 30%
- Lyrical content - 30%
- Harmony and Interpretation- 30%
- Masley - 10%

**e. RECYCLING SHOWCASE** - Two (2) students per category or a total of eight (8) students. Two will make a product out of tin cans or soda cans; another two students will make a product out of used tarpaulins ; another two will create a product out of plastic bottles and another two students will make a product out of styrofoams. The main materials to be used in this contest are categorized to:

1. used **tin can or soda can**,
2. used **tarpaulins**
3. used **styrofoams**
4. used **plastic bottles**

Strictly no pre-assembled materials are allowed. Each product category will be judged differently. Hence, one school may win in one category and another school in the other three categories. Strictly no commercial points is allowed. Participants must maximize the use of their materials. Deduction in their average points will be given based on weight of the materials wasted.

- 5-10grams - 2 points
- 11-15grams - 3 points
- 15-20 grams - 4 points
- greater than 20grams - 5 points

The criteria for judging are as follows:

- Creativity - 30%
- Craftmanship - 30%
- Stability and Durability- 10%
- Usefulness and Functionality- 30%

**f. IMPROMPTU DAYALOGO** - A team is composed of five (5) members. One of which may act as moderator while the other four will exchange ideas. There is no need to take sides on issues. Contestants will simply shares their insights in a manner with humor and wit. The topic shall be picked by the contestants 3 minutes before the time. They will be given 3 minutes to deliver their piece. The criteria for judging are as follows:

- Wit and Humor- 25%
- Relevance to the Topic - 35%
- Unity and Chemistry- 20%
- Stage Presence- 10%
- Audience Impact- 10%

- g. **KABATAAN: BAYANI NG KALIKASAN** – This contest intends to recognize the leadership and innovative skills of the students focusing on the theme: “#Tayoangkalikasan; Protektahan, Alagaan, Mahalin, at Pagyamanin”. Upon registration, the contestant shall submit an essay of at least 300 words (soft copy to be sent to the EPS-Science) as to why he/she deserves to be included in the roster of the contestants. This essay shall be supported with scanned and duly authenticated certificates, news clippings, pictures, audio and video presentations (from SY 2015-2017). Print-out of the essay duly signed by the contestant and noted by the YES-O adviser and school head must be placed in a clear book folder together with the MOV. The criteria for judging are as follows:
- Essay / Supporting Documents/ MOVs – 40 points
  - Panel interview – 40 points
  - Community Impact – 20 points
- h. **ON THE SPOT POSTER MAKING CONTEST** – The medium should be **oil pasted, 8 colors only**. The required base is 1/2 size illustration board. The criteria for judging are as follows:
- Originality of Idea – 30%
  - Relevance to the Topic/Theme – 30%
  - Workmanship – 30%
  - Visual Impact – 10%
- i. **YES-O EXHIBIT** – The school shall display a tarpaulin (4ft x 8ft) containing the best practices of their school, focusing on YES-O's programs, activities, and projects. The presenter shall be either the YES-O President or SSG President. He/she shall prepare a 3-5 minutes powerpoint presentation to showcase the best practices and achievements of the school YES -O program. The criteria for judging are as follows:
- Implementation of the YES-O Mandated Programs and Projects – 50%
  - Bulletin Board Display – 10%
  - Video/Powerpoint Presentation – 10%
  - Interview – 20%
- j. **PALARO PARA SA KALIKASAN** – A total of 24 students (Grades 7-12) will represent the Division of Aklan in the Regional YES-O Congress, composing of four (4) per grade level.
