## **CONTEST MECHANICS**

### **SIYENSIKULA**

1. This competition is open to **ALL Junior and Senior High School students** from both Public and Private Schools in the Division of Aklan. **Maximum of three students** may collaborate on a single video entry. However, it is also possible that only one student will be part of the video entry.
2. The participant/s must discuss a topic under Physical Sciences, Life Sciences, Mathematics or an Engineering concept in a creative, engaging, and illuminating manner through a video presentation that is not more than three (3) minutes in duration.
3. The participants can discuss the topic in English and/or Filipino.
4. All contents in the video must be original and are owned by the participant/s. All creative visual tools such as animations, simulations, physical demonstrations, or visual aids are allowed but all must be originally made by the contestants. Entries with unoriginal photos and videos will automatically be disqualified.
5. Entries must be submitted via email to **cherry.dalipe@deped.gov.ph** not later than April 12, 2021 with a subject format: "SIYENSIKULA\_DISTRICT OF \_\_\_\_\_ SCHOOL\_\_\_\_\_VideoTitle" (ex. SIYENSIKULA\_MALAY\_MALAY NHS\_ LIGTAS).
6. The e-mail should include: (1) the name/s of the participant/s, (2) Youtube video link attachment of the video entry, and (3) a pdf file of the video script along with the references in Chicago Manual of Style. Non-submission of any of the required documents of the competition entry will automatically be disqualified.
7. There will be three stages of the judging process:
  - a) **PEER-TO-PEER REVIEW (1st Stage)** - The Peer-to-Peer Review is the first phase of judging. Entries will be reviewed and scored by the other contestants. The Peer-to-Peer review process is an educational experience and desires with good faith in providing an honest and sincere assessment of the Peers' Entries.

- b) **POPULAR VOTE (2nd Stage)** - The Popular Vote invites the public to participate in the judging process for the Siyensikula through the official facebook page to be created for this purpose. The Popular Vote Entry with the highest combined total of Likes, Shares and positive reactions (Love, Haha, Wow) on the video's original post on the official Facebook page will have an award. Results of reactions from FB and Youtube posts will be tallied. The top-scoring Popular Vote Entry may also receive special recognition for this accomplishment.
- c) **EVALUATION AND SELECTION COMMITTEE REVIEW (3rd Stage)** – The Evaluation and Selection Committee will review and score all the video entries based on the criteria for judging.
8. The results of the Peer-to-Peer Evaluation and Popular Vote are independent with the evaluation results of the Evaluation and Selection Committee. The entry with the highest percentage in the final stage shall be declared as Champion and will be given a medal and a certificate and will be the official representative of the Division of Aklan to the Regional Science Fair.
9. All the Top 10 winning entries will receive certificates and medals and will be posted in the official Facebook page of DepED Aklan and Mga Guro ng Siyensya sa Dibisyon ng Aklan.

- **April 12, 2021** – all video entries must be submitted to the Education Program Supervisor in Science
- **April 14-16, 2021** – duration of posting of the entries in FB and Youtube and only reactions within this duration will be counted

## POSTER-MAKING CONTEST

### a. Digital Poster

1. There will be three categories (a) Elementary (b) Junior High School (c) Senior High School. Judging will be done separately.
2. This contest is **open to all schools in the Division of Aklan**.
3. The poster entries must be in A4 size (Portrait or Landscape) in JPEG/PNG/PSD format.
4. Official entries must include the complete name of the contestant, name of the coach, and the complete name of the school.
5. The final output of each contestant must be submitted via email to **cherry.dalipe@deped.gov.ph** with a subject format: "DIGITAL POSTER\_DISTRICT\_SCHOOL\_Category" (ex. DIGITAL POSTER\_BANGA\_MANGAN ES\_ELEMENTARY).
6. The digital poster for the contest must illustrate, interpret, emphasize, and expound the given theme that will be provided during the competition.
7. Contestants will be given **2 hours** to complete the posters and shall be monitored via Google Meet by the Contest Committee.
8. Non-compliance will result in automatic disqualification.
9. Participants may use any Digital Art software (Photoshop, Paint, Procreate, etc).
10. Any artwork in the poster must be an original design. Poster designs containing clip-art **will not be considered** by judges.
11. The artist will be held accountable to any issues that may arise with regard to the originality and authenticity of the design.
12. A one-paragraph explanation and description of the artwork (in ENGLISH) limited to 100-200 words must be attached to the email upon submission of the entry.
13. The output must be sent immediately after the time allotment ended.

- A **maximum of 3 entries/contestant is allowed per district** to limit the number of entries. (Example: Only 3 elementary, 3 Junior HS, and 3 Senior HS must come from the District of Libacao).
- The poster entries must be in A4 size (Portrait or Landscape) paper.
- Official entries must include the complete name of the contestant, name of the coach, and the complete name of the school.
- The final output of each contestant must be pictured in close up magnification or scanned and submitted via email to **cherry.dalipe@deped.gov.ph** with a subject format: "MANUAL POSTER\_DISTRICT\_SCHOOL\_Category" (ex. MANUAL POSTER\_LEZO\_LEZO IS\_SENIOR HS).

6. The poster for the contest must illustrate, interpret, emphasize, and expound the given theme that will be provided during the competition.
7. Contestants will be given **2 hours** to complete the posters and shall be monitored via Google Meet by the Contest Committee.
8. Non-compliance will result in automatic disqualification.
9. Participants must use **Cray-pas Oil Pastel Color**.
10. Any artwork in the poster must be an original design. Poster designs copied from the internet ***will not be considered*** by judges.
11. The artist will be held accountable to any issues that may arise with regard to the originality and authenticity of the design.
12. A one-paragraph explanation and description of the artwork (in ENGLISH) limited to 100-200 words must be attached to the email upon submission of the entry.
13. The output must be sent immediately after the time allotment ended.

## SCIENCE FAIR JINGLE MAKING CONTEST

1. The contest is **open to all pupils/students from both public and private elementary and secondary schools.**
2. Composer can either be an individual or a team.
3. A maximum of 3 members shall compose a team. This may be performed by 1, 2 or 3 persons.
4. Elementary and Secondary contestants will be judged as one. Coordinators shall register the names of the contestants in one sheet allotted for NSTF Jingle Contest (combined elementary and secondary).
5. The jingle must be an original composition and must not have been used as entry in any song competitions.
6. The content of the jingle must be lively, appealing, creative and must highlight the vision and mission of the National Science Fair. (*The STF aims to promote Science and Technology consciousness among the youth and identify the most creative/innovative and the best Science researchers who will represent the country in international competitions*).
7. The use of offensive and rude words are strictly prohibited.
8. Any musical instrument can be used as accompaniment at the composer's discretion.
9. The jingle must be in mp3 format. Length of Jingle should not be more than three (3) minutes inclusive of intro and outro-music.
10. Jingle Entries together with a brief write up of the entry's inspiration and origin must be submitted via email to **cherry.dalipe@deped.gov.ph** not later than **April 12, 2021** with a subject format: "JINGLE\_SCHOOL\_CATEGORY\_LASTNAME OF COMPOSER/S.
11. Entries may be written in English or Filipino.
12. The winning piece in the national level will be used as the official National Science and Technology Fair jingle in all of its activities and engagement.

13. The right of ownership, shall remain with the original composers of the winning jingle entry. However, DepEd shall be allowed to use the winning entry for the production of an improved version if needed for official use and distribution.

## CONTESTS FOR TEACHERS

### SiyenTIKTOK

1. The contest is open to **all Science Teachers and School Heads who are former Science teachers in the Division of Aklan.**
2. Every district is only allowed to have **at most/not more than four (4) Tiktok entries**, either composing of all Elementary Science Teachers or all Secondary Science Teachers, or Combination of Elementary and Secondary Teachers.
3. Contestant will make a fun, informative, and interesting video using the Tiktok Apps on any Science-related topics, trivia, fun facts, etc. **TikTok** is a short-form, video-sharing app that allows users to create and share 60-second videos.
4. One teacher can create only one Tiktok video as his/her official contest entries.
5. Teachers may perform as a group and present one Tiktok video.
6. The participants must discuss/present the topic in **Filipino or English or Taglish.**
7. Entries must be submitted via email to **cherry.dalipe@deped.gov.ph** or via messenger at the FB Account of the EPS in Science (Chie Mendal) not later than **May 07, 2021** with a subject format: "TIKTOKERIST\_NAME OF TEACHER\_SCHOOL (ex. TIKTOKERIST\_EVA ZASPA\_MAKATO NHS).
10. There will be two stages of the judging process:
  - a) **POPULAR VOTE (1<sup>st</sup> Stage)** - The Popular Vote invites the public to participate in the judging process for the SiyenTiktok through the official Tiktok Account to be created for this purpose. The Popular Vote Entry with the highest heart reacts. The top-scoring Popular Vote Entry may also receive special recognition for this accomplishment.

**b) EVALUATION AND SELECTION COMMITTEE REVIEW (2<sup>nd</sup> Stage)** – The Evaluation and Selection Committee will review and score all the video entries based on the criteria for judging.

11. The results of the Popular Vote is independent with the evaluation results of the Evaluation and Selection Committee.
12. All the Top 10 winning entries will receive certificates and medals and will be posted in the official Facebook page of DepED Aklan and Mga Guro ng Siyensya sa Dibisyon ng Aklan.

## **InnovaTeach**

1. The contest is open to all Science Teachers, both of public and private schools in the Division of Aklan.
2. The entry may be individual (one teacher) or team. The team may have 2 to 5 members coming either from one school or one district.
3. Contestants will present a video showcasing the innovative teaching practices he/she/they have been practicing during this time of pandemic. The focus must be in Science subject.
4. The video must not exceed 5 minutes, to be presented in English and/or Filipino.
5. Together with the video is a written document presenting the innovative practices being done by the Science Teachers.
6. Entries must be submitted via email to **cherry.dalipe@deped.gov.ph** not later than **May 07, 2021** with a subject format: “INNOVATEACH\_DISTRICT OF \_\_\_\_\_ SCHOOL\_\_\_\_\_NAME (ex. INNOVATEACH\_MALINAO\_MSPC\_ VAN ILETO).
7. Should the file be too heavy, video could be sent thru google drive.
8. There will be three stages of the judging process:

**a) POPULAR VOTE (1<sup>st</sup> Stage)** - The Popular Vote invites the public to participate in the judging process for the InnovaTeach through the official facebook page to be created for this purpose. The Popular Vote Entry with the highest combined total of Likes, Shares and positive reactions (Love, Haha, Wow) on the video's original

post on the official Facebook page will have an award. The top-scoring Popular Vote Entry may also receive special recognition for this accomplishment.

**b) EVALUATION AND SELECTION COMMITTEE REVIEW (2nd Stage)** – The Evaluation and Selection Committee will review and score all the video entries based on the criteria for judging.

9. The result of the Popular Vote is independent with the evaluation results of the Evaluation and Selection Committee.
10. All the Top 10 winning entries will receive certificates and medals and will be posted in the official Facebook page of DepED Aklan and Mga Guro ng Siyensya sa Dibisyon ng Aklan.

## **Acrostic Poem Presentation**

1. The contest is open to all Science Teachers, both of public and private schools in the Division of Aklan.
2. The entry may be individual (one teacher) or team. The team may have 2 to 10 members coming either from one school or different schools.
3. Contestants will present a video showing how they recite an acrostic poem. The theme must evolve around Science Teaching specifically in times of pandemic.
4. The video must not exceed 5 minutes, to be presented in English and/or Filipino.
5. Entries must be submitted via email to **cherry.dalipe@deped.gov.ph** not later than **May 07, 2021** with a subject format: “ACROSTIC\_DISTRICT OF \_\_\_\_\_ SCHOOL (ex. ACROSTIC\_KALIBO I\_ RSHSVI).
6. Should the file be too heavy, video could be sent thru google drive.
7. There will be three stages of the judging process:

**a) POPULAR VOTE (1<sup>st</sup> Stage)** - The Popular Vote invites the public to participate in the judging process for the Acrostic Poem Presentation through the official facebook page to be created for this purpose. The Popular Vote Entry with the highest combined total of Likes, Shares and positive reactions (Love, Haha, Wow) on the video's original post on the official Facebook page will have an

award. The top-scoring Popular Vote Entry may also receive special recognition for this accomplishment.
