SCIENCE and TECHNOLOGY RUNWAY

• Futuristic Wear Showcase

- The imaginative creation of tomorrow's world, or of life outside the solar system, is one of the enduring fascinations of science fiction. Alongside production design, costume plays a key role in creating worlds and characters that support stories of future societies, space travel and fantastic other worlds and galaxies.
- The main objective of this show is to show campers how science and technology influence not only the outfit but the way of life of the people.
- Participating teams will pre-design a costume that depicts the future. Male and female member of the team will wear the costume to show them in public.
- Each member will be given one (1) minute to introduce themselves, the team, and to say something about the costume and connect it to Science and Technology in the future. Speech should focus on how Science and Technology could change peoples' lives by citing innovations present in the locality where the student belong.
- In this activity, the engineering skills and craftsmanship of the group will be determined.
- In judging the best among the contestants, the following criteria will be used:
 - a. Stage Projection / Poise and Bearing (25%)
 - b. Intricacy of the Engineering Design Done on the Outfit (25%)
 - c. Relevance to the Theme (10%)
 - d. Content of the Message/ Advocacy (25%)
 - e. Over-all Impact (15%)

• "Wearable Elements of Nature"

- In astrology, the universe is formed by the four elements: *Earth, Air, Fire and Water*. These are the outward manifestations of the true Elements. Each of the four elements contains its own unique properties, which work simultaneously to create one united universe. None of the elements are inherently good or bad, however, each has both positive and negative qualities.
- The Mission: Students are known to be innate artists and love to create and design. They have observed that the environment is already facing various challenges and problems. One of the serious problems is environmental wastes.
- Design a "Wearable Element of Nature" utilizing materials from the environment that may have caused increase in waste or pollution. Convert that material into something wearable and to be worn during the show. Head dress can be worn or any accessories that will strengthen the element being projected.
- Contestants will be given one (1) minute to introduce themselves and to discuss the element they are projecting, focusing on how humans must take care of it and how humans could save it for the future generation.
- In this activity, creativity and resourcefulness among students will be developed so as their love and concern to the environment.
- In judging the best among the contestants, the following criteria will be used:
 - a. Stage Projection / Poise and Bearing (15%)
 - b. Creativity and Craftmanship done in the Outfit (15%)
 - c. Relevance / Adherence to the Theme (15%)
 - d. Use of Recycled and Recyclable materials (15%)
 - e. Content of the Message/ Advocacy (25%)
 - f. Over-all Impact (15%)
