Diorama Making Contest Mechanics

- 3. Diorama size and base limit Base – 24 x 24 inches Height – up to 12 inches
- 4. Materials: preferably made of recycled materials
- 5. Entry should be submitted on August 14, 2017 at Job Y. Besana Hall, AKELCO Lezo, Aklan. Look for Yoko T. Mendoza
- 6. There will be 3 winners in this contest. First Prize P7, 000.00
 Second Prize P5, 000.00
 Third Prize P3, 000.00
- 7. Judging will form part of the program and winners will be announced thereafter.
- 8. Criteria for Judging Creativity – 60% Storytelling/Presentation – 30% Wow factor – 10%
