AKLAN LITERATURE AND ARTS TEACHERS CONVENTION (AkLATCon) 2019

1. This is to inform the field that the Division of Aklan will hold a three-day Aklan Literature and Arts Teachers' Convention (AkLATCon 2019) on November 28-30, 2019 at the KPES Covered Court, Kalibo Pilot Elementary School, Kalibo, Aklan.
2. This activity aims to:
 - a. showcase locally-developed learning resources at different stages of the K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum;
 - b. award SDO-Aklan teachers who contributed to the division's success in the implementation of the LRMDs;
 - c. gather Akeanon teacher-writers and learning resource producers to share their best practices in the implementation of the LRMDs; and
 - d. update the participants on effective production and delivery of learning resources.

4. Each district is encouraged to attend the Keynote Speeches on Days 1 and 2. Likewise, teachers and LR implementers in the schools are invited to attend the Lightning Speeches on Day 3. Refer to Enclosure 2 for the number of participants per district. **"NO DISRUPTION OF CLASSES POLICY" SHALL BE STRICTLY OBSERVED.**
5. Winners of the 3rd National Storybook Writing Contest – Division Level is invited to attend on Day 3 for awarding.
6. The following schools are encouraged to bring at least twenty (25) K-3 pupils for a one-day storytelling event (November 29, 2019) according to a scheduled time:
 - a. Kalibo Pilot Elementary School
 - b. Kalibo Elementary School
 - c. Kalibo Integrated Special Education Center
7. Schools who will bring their pupils to the event shall observe DepEd Order No. 66 (Implementing Guidelines on the Conduct of Off-Campus Activities).
8. Each district is expected to prepare a 2-minute video that will showcase outputs of locally-developed learning resources and best practices in the field. Deadline for submission will be on November 24, 2019 at the DepEd Aklan Division Office.

9. Since part of the activity fall on weekends, the teacher-participants are entitled to Service Credits where they apply in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 entitled "Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers." On the other hand, non-teaching personnel shall be provided with Compensatory Time Off (CTO) as per Civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered.

10. Registration for the said activity is free. Participants are encouraged to bring their own packed lunch and snacks. Related expenses and transportation expenses of the participants may be chargeable against local school MOOE funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
