World Vision Development Foundation, Incorporated (WVDF) thru its Area Program in Culasi is planning to conduct the Community Engagement and Sponsorship Program (CESP) Integrated Baselining this February 2022. The objectives of this activity are the following: 1) Provide benchmarks or status of indicators reflecting on communities' capacities to care for children improve key aspects of their well-being; 2) Identify gaps and relevance of the proposed interventions in the primary focus areas by taking stock on progress of the indicators and achievements in previous program cycle; 3) Assess risks (political, social, and cultural) that challenge or impede in the project implementation; 4) Validate the project theory and relevance of the interventions using the baseline data and status of assumptions; and 5) Provide recommendations or adjustments required, where appropriate, to make the interventions effective and relevant.
