We are from the recently revived Autism Society Philippines - Kalibo Chapter here in Aklan. We are parents, siblings, caregivers and educators of children with autism, and our aim is to increase awareness, acceptance and appreciation of our beloved special kids.

This February, in cooperation with I-Learn Child Center, we are spearheading a seminar-workshop on Autism to be headed by the only **Oral Placement Therapy (OPT)** provider in the country. OPT is one of the new techniques that specifically targets the speech and communication difficulties of children on the **Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)**.

This activity is entitled "Autism 101 Training: Empowering Families, Caregivers, and Educators in Navigating Daily Life with Autism". It will focus on children's challenging behaviors, their communication techniques, and social interactions. This will be on February 22-23, Saturday-Sunday from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm at the Third Floor of the Kalibo Municipal Hall. Registration fee for the 2-day training is Php 1,500.00 per attendee. The fee covers the speakers' professional and travel fees, and will include the participants' certificates. Snacks will be served.

This seminar will especially include a **demonstration-workshop**, featuring some of our autism kids, so the participants will see how they can apply the theories they have been taught.

Our target audience for this training are those who are involved with autism children - families and caregivers who provide the day-to-day care at home and in social settings, and educators who are in-charge of the kids' academic progress and their interactions with other students.

We are inviting your teachers and guidance counsellors to participate. This is, indeed, a rare opportunity for them. They will acquire a deeper understanding of their special kids in class, so they may be better equipped to handle all kinds of children in the school.
