BKD VIRTUAL CONTESTS

1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 124, dated November 26, 2001 title (DECLARING THE THIRD WEEK OF NOVEMBER OF EVERY YEAR AS DRUG ABUSE PREVENTION AND CONTROL WEEK) the third week of November of every year has been declared as Drug Abuse Prevention and Control Week to promote public awareness against the evil effects of illegal drug use as well as public cooperation in the government's anti-drug campaign. With this, the Youth Formation Section of the School Governance and Operations Division – of this office, will launch an online ***BKD VIRTUAL CONTESTS*** with the theme, "Share Facts on Drugs, Save Lives."
2. These contests aim to improve the understanding of the world's drug problem and how, in turn, better knowledge will foster greater international cooperation for countering its impact on health, governance, and security.
3. These contests are open to all public schools, both elementary and secondary. The guidelines to this activity are found in the enclosures.
4. It is understood that in the conduct of this activity, as stated in the DO No. 66, s. 2017 (Implementing Guidelines on the conduct of Off-Campus Activities), all must observe the following:
 - a. ensure relevance and alignment with educational competencies of the K to 12 curriculum and Leadership Development Learners;
 - b. uphold child protection principles and that no learners shall be disadvantaged in any form; and
 - c. observe the safety and security protocols for all the participants before, during and after the activity.

5. Compliance with health and safety protocols are to be observed as articulated in the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines with amendments as of June 30, 2021 as well as existing health protocols in the locality.
6. Expenses incurred relative to the conduct of this activity shall be charged from the Special Education Fund of the Province of Aklan, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

BKD SHORT FILM MAKING CONTEST

1. Each participating district shall register only two entries: one secondary, and one elementary. Maximum number of participants per entry is seven (7), composed of any member of the family of the learner/s. Each group may contribute to the creation of the video, such as but not limited to one being the writer, other members will be the actor/voice talent, and others as video and audio editor/s. This activity shall be done online and physical interaction is highly discouraged.
2. The short film must revolve around the theme, "Share facts on Drugs, Save Lives." Each entry is given a minimum of three (3) minutes and maximum of five (5) minutes.
3. English, Filipino, and Akeanon may be used in the short film may be used and must not contain any malicious and offensive content.
4. Use of instrumental or background music is allowed to complement the short film. No deduction shall be made if the contestant opts not to use musical background.
5. The entry shall be in mp4 format. The contestant is free to use any means to convey the message more effectively.
6. The following criteria shall serve as basis for judging:
 - a. Organization (clarity of thought, structure, coherence)..... 25%
 - b. Delivery and Style (unique storytelling, performance).....25%
 - c. Video Presentation (creativity, sound, and picture quality)..25%
 - d. Content (depth of concept, relevance to the theme).....25%Total – 100%
7. 8. The deadline of counting of views for People’s Choice Award will be on November 26, 2021.
9. All entries submitted shall be considered joint property of DepEd Aklan and the artist/s and may be used by DepEd Aklan without notice to the artist/s.
10. There shall be top three (3) winners and shall be awarded of the following prizes:
 - a. 1st Place = Php5,000.00 worth of school supplies
 - b. 2nd Place = Php3,000.00 worth of school supplies
 - c. 3rd Place = Php2,000.00 worth of school supplies
 - d. Special Category: People’s Choice Award

4. The deadline of counting of heart emoticon for People's Choice Award will be on November 26, 2021.

9. Criteria for judging:
 - a. 35% - Relevance
 - b. 25% - Creativity and originality
 - c. 40% - Craftsmanship (overall artistic appearance)

 - a. 1st Place = Php3,000.00 worth of school supplies
 - b. 2nd Placc = Php2,000.00 worth of school supplies
 - c. 3rd Place = Php1,000.00 worth of school supplies
