- It is understood that in the conduct of this event, as stated in DO No. 66, s. 2017 (Implementing Guidelines on the conduct of Off-Campus Activities), all must observe the following:
  - a) Ensure relevance and alignment with educational competencies of the K to 12 curriculum and Leadership Development of Learners;
  - Uphold child protection principles and that no learners shall be disadvantaged in any form; and
  - Observe the safety and security protocols for all the participants before, during and after the activity.
- Adherence to health protocols (Refer to D.O. No. 14, s. 2020 Guidelines on the required Health Standards in Basic Education Offices and Schools) of every participant shall be strictly observed. Participation shall be subject to compliance with existing quarantine restrictions.
- 4. The participants to this activity are entitled to Service Credits for their services rendered during weekends and holidays but not to exceed 15 days per year in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 titled: Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to teachers. On the other hand, non-teaching personnel shall be provided with Compensatory Time Off (CTO) for their services rendered during weekend and holidays as per Civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget and management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered.
