- 3. Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) School Coordinator must submit a report of the activity of the school relative to the Conduct of Regional Climate Change Caravan 2021 to the District DRRM Coordinator on or before November 15, 2021. District DRRM Coordinators must submit a soft copy of the consolidated report of schools to the Schools Division of Aklan Division Office - Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office, Attn: CHARLIE I. URETA, PDO-II on or before November 17, 2021.
- 4. Expenses for materials and other incidental expenses in the conduct of this activity shall be charged against school MOOE and other local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 5. Wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

CONDUCT OF THE REGIONAL CLIMATE CHANGE CARAVAN 2021 CONCEPT NOTE

THEME: CLIMATE CHANGE ADAPTATION INITIATIVES IN THE HOME OF CHAMPIONS

RATIONALE:

Climate change events including sea level rise, increased frequency of extreme weather events, rising temperatures, and heavy rainfall all pose a threat to the Philippines. Activities conducted online are preferred.

Should activities require face-to-face/in-person activities, IATF Protocol and minimum health standards must be followed strictly. If possible, clearance or approval from local IATF must be secured.

Students should not be involved for any face-to-face/in-person activities.

All Pre-Caravan Activity should be documented.

Promote the Climate Change Caravan Activity by developing IEC materials and/or campaigns to posted through social media subject to the approval of the DRRMS and Learning Resource Materials Office.

Actual Climate Change Caravan Activity

Divisions good practices in CCAM will be shown as informercials or trailers in between the messages and the main feature of the Regional Climate Change Caravan event.

The actual caravan activity will feature the Farm Schools in the Region and Home Gardening in relation to Food Security, Bulata NHS in Cauayan, Negros Occidental "Wala Usik Project" for Ecological and Environmental Stability and the Theater type presentation of IEC Materials on Inclusive Climate Change Adaptation for Knowledge and Capacity Development.

This will be broadcast through DepEd Tayo Western Visayas - FB Live Streaming.

A Filipino Sign Language interpreter will be included during the activity.


