- 3. The 2018 Brigada Eskwela School Forms are attached to this Memorandum as Appendices A to K including BE Forms 01-07.
- 4. For the Search for Best Implementing Schools, each District shall submit eight (8) entries only: four (4) entries from the elementary level category (i.e., 1 small school, 1 medium school, 1 large school and 1 mega school) and the same number of entries for the secondary level.
- 5. All entries must be endorsed by the Public Schools District Supervisor/Principal-In-Charge of the District/Head Teacher In-Charge of the District.
- 6. Integrated Schools will be identified by the SDO whether to compete in elementary or secondary level.
- 7. The 2018 Brigada Eskwela (BE) Implementing Schools are required to have a logbook that reflects the day-today attendance of volunteers and visitors alike.
- 8. The school Information and Communications Technology (ICT) coordinators shall be involved in the documentation of the BE activities and documents.
- 9. The checklist for the 2018 Brigada Eskwela Best School Implementer documents shall include the following:
 - a. A-4 side folder and must be in clear book only
 - b. total number of attendance only with MOVs (Mode of Verification / pictures)
 - c. summaries only with substantial attachments such as pictures and POW (Program of Works)
 - d. DepEd buildings cannot be counted as resource generated for BE. However, the Scope of Work in the POW is accepted as resource generated.
 - e. The reason for the choice of facilities and/or trees should be clearly stated.

- f. All donations to the school to be documented as resources generated shall have a corresponding Deed of Donation and Deed of Acceptance.
- g. special programs as indicators of resources generated for BE
- h. school readiness such as the safety of the buildings and facilities
- school Site Development Plan (SDP) representations as follows: reflecting the smoothness of Traffic Routing within the school peripheries, school Emergency Plan (in case of fire or earthquake) and the Evacuation Map
- Use of school stage and transparency walls as update areas for the day-to-day BE 2018 activities (daily updated abstract of criteria)
- k. school projects aligned with the School Improvement Plan (SIP) / Annual Improvement Plan (AIP) or the SDP reflecting the physical improvements in the school (before and after) prior to BE 2018
- I. maintain a video of day-to-day BE activities for documentation purposes
- m. inventory of indemic (naturally localized) and endangered trees, flora and fauna within the school property lot as resources or resource generated
- n. creation of wetlands as a strategy to mitigate flood areas and water cesspools in schools is encouraged, the wetlands being planted with species that strain pollutants as they enter the soil such as nipa and bakhawan trees, to be documented as resource for oxygenation in the school
- inventory of grass areas (in square meters) by specie (carabao grass, wire grass, tihoe-tihoe) as resources or resource generated, strainer of soil/environment pollutants or as medical affluent/s
- p. inventory of oxygenation produced by existing trees within the school property lot as resources or resource generated
- q. rehabilitation measures of dying trees and plants done by the school as resources or resource generated
- r. public information dissemination on the awareness of Boracay closure could be included as resource generated
- s. school sub-theme to the 2018 BE theme attuned to the Boracay closure (measures / mitigation programs to avoid the ills that led to the closure of Boracay such as observance of proper setbacks and the provisions of PD 1097 or the National Building Code
- t. Indigenous People (IP) program for BE
- Best practices on the natural way of preventing pollution by the School Student Government (SSG) / School Pupil Government (SPG) / PTA implementing waste management
- v. scientific / unique presentation
- SDO officials who are members of the Division Evaluation Team and are Judges for the Search for 2018 BE Best Implementers shall provide Technical Assistance (TA) to requesting schools.
- SDO officials who are members of the Division Evaluation Team and are Judges for the Search for 2018 BE Best Implementers may conduct

ocular inspection / monitoring as one group per request of the school/s.

- 12. Expenses to be incurred shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 13. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
