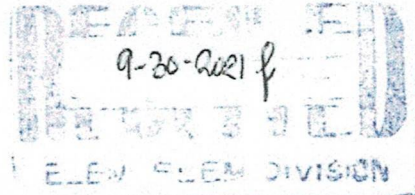

Moreover, keynote sessions, lectures, and press conferences await participants who will take on the challenge. This event is open to all bona fide students enrolled in any school or university in the country for A.Y. 2021-2022. There will be **NO REGISTRATION FEE** and **NO LIMIT** on the number of representatives per school.


