## DIVISION ENHANCEMENT TRAINING IN TEACHING CONTENT OF PHILIPPINE HISTORY USING DIFFERENTIATED INSTRUCTIONS, PEDAGOGIES AND INNOVATIVE SUPPORT INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS

- Teachers play a crucial role in nation building. Through quality teachers, the Philippines can develop holistic learners who are steeped in values, equipped with 21st century skills and able to propel the country to development and progress. The teachers, being the focal figure in education must be competent, knowledgeable and equipped with strategies for developing creative and critical thinking. If teachers' teaching style and support instructional materials fit in a class and is used consistently, then students are motivated to learn.
- 2. In this light, DepEd-Aklan through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will conduct the Division Enhancement Training in Teaching Content of Philippine History Using Differentiated Instructions, Pedagogies and Innovative Support Instructional Materials on September 27-29, 2018 at the Aklan State University-CIT Cafeteria, Kalibo, Aklan.
- 3. The training aims to: enhance the teacher's teaching styles in teaching Philippine History, update teachers' knowledge and insights in content and practices in teaching present history lesson in the K+ 12 Curriculum through innovative methodologies and pedagogies; and develop creative and functional support instructional materials that will enhance teaching and learning process in teaching Philippine History meaningful and interesting.
- 4. Each district will send six (6) Araling Panlipunan teachers comprising of Grades 4-6 (two teachers from grade 4, two teachers from grade 5 and two teachers from grade 6)preferably the untrained/newly deployed /less than 5 years in service and one (1) District Elementary Araling Panlipunan Coordinator.
- 5. The expenses relative to the conduct of the said activity such as supplies, certificates, tarpaulin, reproduction of materials and other related expenses shall be charged against Division HRDT Fund. A registration fee of five hundred pesos (Php 500.00) shall be charged each participant to cover meals and venue. The travel expenses of the trainors/facilitators and the registration fee of the participants shall be charged against school/local fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

- 6. Participation to this activity is subject to the no-disruption-of-classes policy as stipulated in DepEd Order No.9, s. 2005, entitled "Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance therewith". The school head should take the necessary measure to ensure that the teaching load of the Araling Panlipunan Teacher-Participants/Coordinators and Trainers will be taken cared of and NO classes will be missed by the learners.
- 7. Furthermore, trainers and teacher-participants are entitled to 1-day service credit where it applies in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s.2003 entitled: Updating Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers".
