In connection thereof, the School Health and Nutrition Section will conduct the Division Kick off on July 19, 2019, Friday at 9:00AM at Gen. F. Castillo Memorial Elementary School, Mabilo, Kalibo, Aklan. Participants to this Activity who have their own vehicle are enjoined to join the motorcade that will commence at 7:30 AM of the same date. Assembly place is at the Division Office.
2. Participants to this activity are the Schools Division Superintendent, Assistant Schools Division Superintendent, Chief Education Program Supervisor (SGOD), SGOD Education Program Supervisor, Senior /Education Program Specialist, Chief Curriculum Implementation Division, Public Schools District Supervisors (9), Medical Officer III, Dentists, Division Nurses, Senior High School Nurses and Secondary School Nurses, District Health Coordinators and the Job Order of School Health and Nutrition Section as documentor.
3. The purpose of this activity is to strengthen the implementation of the health care services featuring but not limited to the six Major DepEd school health programs below:
 - a. School Based Feeding Program (SBFP);
 - b. National Drug Education Program (NDEP);
 - c. Adolescent Reproductive Health (ARH) Program;
 - d. Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (WASH) in Schools (WinS) Program;
 - e. Medical, Nursing, and Dental Services; and
 - f. School Mental Health Program.
4. Each district is encouraged to showcase their Best practices during their implementation of the OK sa DepEd programs last school year in a tarpaulin to be used as exhibit during the kick off.

OPLAN KALUSUGAN SA DEPED ONE HEALTH WEEK

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order (DO) No. 28, s. 2018 entitled **Policy and Guidelines on Oplan Kalusugan sa Department of Education (OK sa DepEd)**, all public schools are encouraged to observe a nationwide **Oplan Kalusugan sa DepEd One Health Week** from July 22-26, 2019.

2. One Health Week will be conducted to roll out a set of health activities featuring, but not limited to, the six major DepEd school health programs below:

- a. School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP);
- b. National Drug Education Program (NDEP);
- c. Adolescent Reproductive Health (ARH) Program;
- d. Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (WASH) in Schools (WinS) Program;
- e. Medical, Nursing, and Dental Services; and
- f. School Mental Health Program.

3. During the One Health Week, the regional offices (ROs), schools division offices (SDOs), and elementary and secondary schools are directed to undertake the following suggested activities, among others:

- a. Orientation of parents, communities, partners, and other stakeholders;
- b. Delivery of age-appropriate health services;
- c. Launching of age-appropriate health and hygiene practices;
- d. Conduct of feeding activities and school gardening activities;
- e. Exhibits/fora on the NDEP, ARH, school mental health, and comprehensive tobacco control; and
- f. Open house of canteens featuring healthy food and beverage choices.

4. One Health Week shall be maximized to mobilize the community and promote collaboration with partners and stakeholders, especially at the school level. As such, the schools are tasked to network with partners within their localities for various health endeavors such as the improvement and maintenance of health facilities; provision of health and nutrition services including manpower, medicines, and equipment; and finalization of deliverables and schedule of joint health activities for the school year.

5. The ROs and SDOs shall conduct kick-off activities **on or before July 22, 2019** to signal the start of One Health Week and gain support from partners and stakeholders. The national kick-off to be led by the Bureau of Learner Support Services-School Health Division is scheduled on **July 24, 2019**. A separate memorandum shall be issued inviting concerned DepEd personnel and providing further details about the activity.
6. Schools should coordinate with their division health personnel for the conduct of activities for One Health Week.
7. For reporting purposes, the schools shall ensure the documentation of the activities conducted during the One Health Week, following the data requirements of the *OK sa DepEd* Forms A and B enclosed to DO 28, s. 2018.
8. Regional directors and schools division superintendents are enjoined to support and monitor the activities.
