DIVISION ROLL-OUT ON CYBERSAFETY

**To: Chief Education Supervisors

1. Pursuant to the 1987 Constitution, the state shall defend the right of children to assistance, including proper care and nutrition and special protection from all forms of neglect, abuse, cruelty, exploitation and other conditions prejudicial to their development.
2. In addition, DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012 (Child Protection Policy) provides that the Division Office shall conduct advocacy campaigns, capability building, information dissemination activities, and in-service training for teachers on the protection of children in school from abuse, violence, exploitation, discrimination, bullying or peer abuse and other related cases.
3. In this connection, there will be a Live-in Division Roll-Out on Cybersafety at Hotel Metro and Skybar Restaurant, Kalibo, Aklan on December 17-19, 2019.
4. This training aims to: a. strengthen awareness on cybersafety; b. integrate and demonstrate cybersafety and child protection in Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao lessons; and c. value the importance of cybersafety as an intervention and prevention program of the government to address issues on child abuse.
5. Each district shall send the following participants:


- 1 Child Protection/GAD Coordinator-Elementary
- 1 Child Protection/GAD Coordinator-Secondary
- 1 EsP Coordinator-Elementary
- 1 EsP Coordinator-Secondary
- 1 EsP Teacher (Elementary/Secondary)

Total: 5 Participants per District

6. Participants shall bring Curriculum and Teaching Guides in Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao, laptop and extension cords.
7. The training Matrix is found in Enclosure No. 1 of this Memorandum.
8. Teacher-participants are entitled to Service Credits where they apply in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, 20013 entitled: "Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits for Teachers." On the other hand, non-teaching personnel including the management staff shall be provided with Compensatory Time Off (CTO) as per Civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on Non-Teaching Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered.
9. "It is understood that in the conduct of this activity, there shall be no discrimination in the provision of Learning and Development interventions on the account of age, school, gender, civil status, disability, religion or other similar factors/personal circumstances that run counter to the principles of equal opportunity."
10. Expenses relative to this activity shall be charged against the Division GAD Budget while travel expenses of the participants shall be charged against local/ school MOOE funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
11. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is earnestly desired.
