DIVISION SCIENCE FAIR 2019

To: **Chief Education Supervisors**

Science Teachers Concerned / Teacher Coaches

1. Science investigatory projects are prepared to apply/demonstrate scientific principles or attempt to provide new knowledge; to take part in a continuing or parallel scientific research and investigation; and to contribute to the advancement of Science and Technology Education geared towards the development of the community.
2. This year's theme is "**Environmental Conservation and Life Preservation thru Science Advances and Innovations**"
3. Understanding its significance, the DepEd–Division of Aklan will conduct the **DIVISION SCIENCE FAIR** on **September 26, 2019** (Elementary Level) at the **Aguinaldo T. Repiedad Sr. Integrated School, Banga, Aklan** and **September 27, 2019** (Junior and Senior High School) at the **Malinao School for Philippine Craftsmen, Malinao, Aklan**.
4. The categories will be **Life Science (Individual), Life Science (Team), Physical Science (Individual), Physical Science (Team), Robotics (Individual) and Robotics (Team)**. For **Life Science and Physical Science**, only the **Top 2** in the division will be allowed to join in the regional competition. However, **all entries in the Robotics can join in the regional competition**.
5. Please submit **three (3) copies** of the manuscript to the Education Program Supervisor in Science. The deadline for submission of the SIP entries with complete INTEL ISEF Forms will be on or before **September 23, 2019**. Please use the attached Pre-Registration Form to submit names of contestants and coaches.

6. Elementary SIP participants may have maximum of **four (4)** members in their team while the Junior/Senior High School may have a maximum of **three (3)** members as stipulated in the National DepEd Memorandum No. 117, s.2015.
7. Every district is encouraged to come up with at least one (1) entry from the elementary level and one (1) entry from the secondary level. Regional Science High School for Region VI is encouraged to have at least five (5) entries in each category (Biological/Physical Science/Robotics). Special Science Schools (SSES and STE) are encouraged to have at least one (1) in each category (Biological/Physical Science).
8. A registration fee of **one hundred pesos (Php100.00)** per contestant and per coach will be collected to cover expenses for the contest materials, stage decorations, honoraria of the judges, and other operational expenses related thereto. Registration fee, travel expenses and other allowable expenses may be charged against local/school board/club funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing procedures.
9. To showcase the Science Investigatory Projects to be exhibited by the student researchers and to expose teachers who have not done any research works/investigatory project, the Division Science Fair will be open to interested schools in the Division of Aklan on the below indicated schedule:

September 26, 2019 (Division Science Fair for Elementary Level)

- Grades 3 to 6 Science teachers (public and private schools) who are interested to mentor pupils in the conduct of Science Investigatory Projects

September 27, 2019 (Division Science Fair for Secondary Level)

- Grades 7 to 10 Science teachers (public and private schools) who are interested to mentor Junior High School students in the conduct of Science Investigatory Projects
- Grades 11 to 12 teachers (public and private schools) handling Science and Practical Research subjects

10. Teacher spectators/observers will have the opportunity to see the poster displays, to interview student researchers as to how they did their project, and gather ideas as to how other participating schools have done their papers. This is to awaken other teachers' interest in research. They will only be allowed to observe and see the displays from 9:00 AM to 12:00 NN since the afternoon session will be allotted for Oral Defense.

11. District Science Coordinators will act as Facilitators during the contest, hence, their attendance is highly needed.
12. Immediate and wide dissemination of the content of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.
