**DIVISION SEMINAR-WRITESHOP ON THE DEVELOPMENT OF
CONTEXTUALIZED DAILY LESSON LOGS IN MATHEMATICS
and ECHO TRAINING ON INTERDISCIPLINARY
CONTEXTUALIZATION(Icon)
FOR MATHEMATICS EDUCATION**

1. In support of the Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013, this Division will conduct a **Division Seminar-Writeshop on the Development of Contextualized Daily Lesson Logs** and **Echo Interdisciplinary Contextualization (Icon) for Mathematics Education** on **October 4 - 6, 2017** at the **Aklan State University-College of Industrial Technology (ASU-CIT) Function Hall**, Kalibo, Aklan.
 2. This seminar-writeshop aims to:
 - a. capacitate mathematics teachers in developing lessons that are directly linked to day-to-day life experiences in the context of other disciplines;
 - b. equip teachers with necessary skills in integrating localization and contextualization in the preparation of the daily lesson logs; and
 - c. integration of localized strategies and localized assessments in the daily lesson logs.
 3. A maximum of six (6) participants (1 per grade level) per district including the District Elementary Mathematics Coordinator for the elementary Level and one (1) Secondary School Mathematics Coordinator per school for the Junior High School Level. They are expected to be at the venue at 7:00 A.M. for the registration. The opening program will start immediately at 8:00 o'clock in the morning. School heads should assign teachers to take over the participants teaching loads to ensure that classes are not missed.
 4. The participants are requested to bring the following:
 - a. Laptop and extension cord;
 - b. Curriculum Guides (CGs);
 - c. Teaching Guides (TGs); and
 - d. Learning Materials (LMs)

5. No registration fee shall be charged to elementary teacher participants. However, **secondary teacher participants shall pay a registration fee of One Thousand Two Hundred Pesos (P1,200.00)** to cover snacks and lunch, materials, venue, certificates and other incidental expenses. Travel expenses and per diem of each participant shall be charged against LOCAL FUNDS subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
