DIVISION TRAINING OF SCHOOL HEADS AND TEACHERS ON MULTI-FACTORED ASSESSMENT TOOL (MFAT)

To: Chief Education Supervisors

Heads of Public Elementary and Integrated Schools

- 1. In order to strengthen the implementation of the K to 12 Basic Education Program, this Division through the Curriculum Implementation Division will conduct a **Division Training of School Heads and Teachers on Multi-Factored Assessment Tool (MFAT)** on October 10-12, 2019. The venue will be announced later.
- 2. The activity aims to achieve the following objectives:
 - a. Walkthrough the MFAT forms and acquire knowledge in the administration of this tool;
 - b. Experience the actual process of preparation of assessment materials following the specification provided;
 - Simulate the test administration by demonstrating the use of materials per assessment activity and conduct the return demonstration;
 - d. Identify the different difficulties of learners with special educational needs; and
 - e. Present an Action Plan for the conduct of the said training in the district
- 3. There will be five (5) participants from each district: the Public Schools District Supervisor; (1) elementary school head; (1) District Kindergarten Coordinator; and (2) Grade One teachers. They will compose the District Training Team in their respective districts. In the case of the PSDS's who handle more than one district, they shall send a representative to complete the given slot.
- 4. The Division Training Team and TWG as well as the participants shall be given service credits/compensatory day-off for the services rendered during weekends per Dep Ed Order 53 s. 2003, Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Service Credits.
- 5. The expenses incurred for the conduct of this activity shall be charged to HRTD Fund while transportation expenses of the participants and trainers are chargeable against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

- 6. In preparation for the activity, there will be a **Pre-Training Conference and Walkthrough of Trainers** on **September 28** and **October 5**, 8:00 o'clock in the morning to 5:00 o'clock in the afternoon at the **Arthur S. Juada Hall**, Division Office, Kalibo, Aklan.
- 7. The List of Participants, Trainers and Training Matrix are found in Enclosures No. 1 and 2, respectively.
- 8. Immediate and widest dissemination of this Memorandum is earnestly desired.
