



**WORKSHOP ON THE CONTEXTUALIZATION OF
ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM BASIC LITERACY LEARNING MATERIALS (ALS BLLM)**

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. The Bureau of Learning Resources (BLR) in coordination with the DepED - Regional Office VI through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) will conduct a Workshop on the Contextualization of Alternative Learning System Basic Literacy Materials (ALS BLLM) in Akeanon and Kinaray-a on September 20-30, 2019 at The Grand Tower Suites, Iznart St., Iloilo City. Along with this, a one-day Validation Activity shall take place on September 27, 2019 at the following venues:

2. The main objective of this activity is to redevelop the ALS BLLM in the context of Aklan (Akeanon) and Antique (Kinaray-a).
3. The participants to these activities are the identified writers, editors, layout artists, illustrators, and selected Regional CLMD and Schools Division CID Personnel. They will be joined in by personnel from the Bureau of Learning Resources (BLR). They are requested to bring laptop with photoshop/illustrator/in-design software, illustration gadget/equipment, if any, extension cord, internet connectivity device and ALS Curriculum Guide for reference. The list of participants is found in Enclosure No. 1 to this memorandum.
4. The participants are expected to arrive at the venue on day 0 (September 20) with dinner as the first meal and the last meal is PM Snacks of day 10 (September 30).
5. Participation to this activity is subject to the no-disruption-of-classes policy as stipulated in DepED Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled "Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and ensuring Compliance Therewith". The school heads should take necessary measure to ensure that the teaching load of the teacher-participants will be taken cared-off and NO classes will be missed by the learners.
6. Since part of the activity fall on weekends, the teacher-participants are entitled to Service Credits where they apply in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 entitled: "Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers". On the other hand, non-teaching personnel including the management staff shall be provided with Compensatory Time Off (CTO) as per Civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered.
7. The board and lodging, transportation expenses of regional/division office participants and supplies and materials for the workshop are chargeable against downloaded funds intended for the activity while the transportation expenses of the contextualization team along with the food and transportation

expenses of the participants during the validation activity shall be chargeable against BLR downloaded fund transferred to the schools division offices through Letter Release Order (LRO) subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

8. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
