  - a. ensure relevance and alignment with educational competencies of the K to 12 curriculum and Leadership Development Learners;
  - b. uphold child protection principles and that no learners shall be disadvantaged in any form; and
  - c. observe the safety and security protocols for all the participants before, during and after the activity.
5. Compliance with health and safety protocols are to be observed as articulated in the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines with amendments as of June 30, 2021 as well as existing health protocols in the locality.
6. All expenses incurred relative for this activity shall be charged to local funds and Youth Formation Program Support Funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
