1. In order to strengthen the Mother Tongue Multilingual-Based Education (MTB-MLE) under the K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum Program Delivery System for K to 3 learners, the DepEd- Division of Aklan through the Curriculum Implementation Division will conduct the Division Writeshop on the Proposed Akeanon Orthography using the KWF Template and Development of Mother Tongue Primer for Akeanon-Nabasnnon, Malaynon, Buruanganon, Bukidnon and Malaynon Inati on November 7, 8 and 9, 2018 at Arthur S. Juada Hall, DepEd-Division Office, Kalibo, Aklan.

2. The objectives of the activity are:

- a. to write the proposed Akeanon Orthography using the KWF templates as a requirement for the approval and recognition of the Akeanon as a language by the Komisyon ng Wikang Filipino;
- b. to finalize the Mother Tongue Resource Guide with inclusions of Additive Languages for Akeanon variations such as Nabasnnon, Malaynon and Buruanganon; and
- c. to develop Mother Tongue Primer for the Akeanon variations such as Nabasnnon, Malaynon and Buruanganon.
