

AN ORDER STRICTLY IMPLEMENTING RESOLUTION NO. 148-B, SERIES OF 2021, DATED NOVEMBER 11, 2021 ISSUED BY THE NATIONAL INTERAGENCY TASK FORCE FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF EMERGING INFECTIOUS DISEASES (IATF-EID) IN THE PROVINCE OF AKLAN.

WHEREAS, Section 15, Article II of the 1987 constitution states that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill consciousness among them;

WHEREAS, pursuant thereto, on November 11, 2021, the IATF-EID issued Resolution No. 148-B, Series of 2021, providing guidelines and policies for a healthier and resilient Philippines;

NOW THEREFORE, I, FLORENCIO T. MIRAFLORES, Governor of the Province of Aklan, by virtue of the authority vested in me by law, hereby ADOPTS Resolution No. 148-B issued by the IATF-EID, and ORDAINS to wit:

SECTION 1. VACCINATION REQUIREMENT FOR EMPLOYEES. All establishments and employees in the Public and Private Sector SHALL require their eligible employees (permanent, contractual, job orders, probational, trainees, etc.) who are tasked to do on-site work TO BE VACCINATED AGAINST Covid-19.

Eligible employees who remain to be unvaccinated may not be terminated solely by reason thereof. **HOWEVER**, they shall be required to undergo RT-PCR tests regularly (every two weeks) at their own expense for purposes of on-site work.

SECTION 2. TRANSPORT SECTOR. Eligible employees/workers of the public transportation services shall likewise be required to be fully vaccinated as a condition for their continued operation.

Enforcement agencies (PNP, LTO, HPG, PCG, PNP Maritime Group, PNP AVESGROUP) are enjoined to strictly implement this provision.

SECTION 3. VACCINATION REQUIREMENT FOR THE TRANSACTING PUBLIC. Public and Private establishments may validly refuse entry and/or deny service to individuals who remain unvaccinated or are merely partially vaccinated, despite being eligible for vaccination. *Provided*, that frontline and emergency services shall continue to render assistance to all persons regardless of vaccination status.

SECTION 4. EXEMPTION FROM THE VACCINATION REQUIREMENT. Only the presentation of a medical clearance issued by a Municipal Health Office, City Health Office and/or Provincial Health Office or birth certificate shall serve as sufficient and valid proof of ineligibility for vaccination.

SECTION 5. PRIVILEGE OF VACCINATED INDIVIDUALS. Fully vaccinated individuals are given priority in availing government programs and services.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect on January 17, 2022.
