1. PISA or Programme for International Study Assessment has been established as one of the main measures of how successful education is in many countries. PISA aims to measure how well 15-year-old learners are prepared to meet the challenges of today's knowledge societies.

5. Participants to the orientation are the Division Office Personnel identified, school head of the representative schools, teachers to be involved in PISA, School ICT Coordinator, and other school personnel to be involved in PISA.
