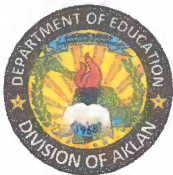

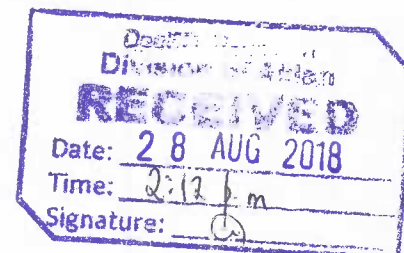

In connection to this, we do appeal for your generous financial assistance. Any financial help that you can extend to her would mean a lot because it signifies your support in her struggle for survival.

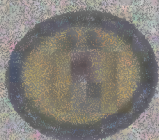

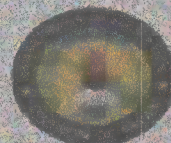


