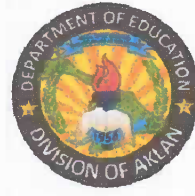



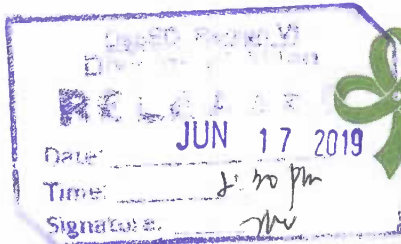

This event is a 2 ½-day training for Senior and Cadet Girl Scouts who are members of Junior Journalist Guild or Radio TV Club. This training aims to activate the role of citizens, specifically Girl Scouts, in the process of collecting, reporting, analyzing, and disseminating news to the public using conventional media and the internet to spread information.

1. Must be a registered Senior or Cadet Girl Scout as of December 2018, aged 15-21
2. Must be a member of the Council's Junior Journalists Guild or Radio TV Club
3. Must have basic media skills (writing, video and photo-taking using smartphones)
4. Must have participated in a GSP camp or training event prior to this workshop

To ensure slots, councils must send the full name of their participant along with the filled-out GSP Information Sheet and Parent's Consent Form, by email to your region, and copy furnished Communications Division in communicationsgsp@gsaaff.org before June 15, 2019.

Arrival at the Center:

The participants are expected to arrive on Day 1, Friday, 8:00 AM. Participants who will arrive before Friday must inform their region and the Communications Division, one week before the scheduled training. Any additional accommodation fee at the center will be shouldered by the participant.

Registration Payment:

Registration fees must be paid to the Region not later than June 21, 2019. Your payment will be our basis for the rooming assignments at the center.
