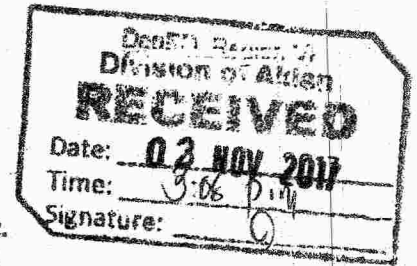

RESOLUTION HIGHLIGHTING THE IMPORTANCE OF GODOFREDO RAMOS DAY ON NOVEMBER 8 BY RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING ALL SECONDARY SCHOOLS IN KALIBO TO ENCOURAGE THEIR STUDENTS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PORTRAIT PAINTING CONTEST COMMEMORATING THE "FATHER OF AKLAN" AT THE MUSEO IT AKEAN

WHEREAS, the province of Aklan celebrates Godofredo Peralta Ramos Day every year on November 3 in honor of the "Father of Aklan," who was born on November 8, 1911;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Kalibo should take a leading role among all towns in commemorating "Tay Goding", as he was fondly called, especially since it is the educational heart of the province, and it is where Godofredo P. Ramos spent many of his cherished moments and achieved many of his milestones for the welfare of his fellow Aklanons;

WHEREAS, the Kalibonhon youth already have an excellent resource on the "Father of Aklan" by virtue of the Goding Ramos exhibit at the Museo it Akean, and schools need only to require or encourage their students to visit the place;



**106th Godofredo P. Ramos Day
Portrait Painting Contest**

November 8, 2017, 9:30 AM – 12:00 PM

Museo it Akean, Kalibo, Aklan

Held by the Aklan Historical Society, Godofredo P. Ramos Foundation, Museo it Akean, Provincial Government of Aklan

Eligibility Requirements

- This contest is for Aklanon junior and senior high school students.
- Each school may have 2 participants.
- Registration is accepted at the Kalibo Tourism Office, 2F, Kalibo Municipal Hall and the Museo it Akean. There is no registration fee. Each participant must present her/his school ID.
- Deadline of registration is on November 7, 2017.

Evaluation Criteria

- This is an on-the-spot contest on November 8, 2017 from 9:30 AM to 12:00 PM at the Museo it Akean. Winners will be announced afterwards at the same venue.
- Subject: Portrait of Tay Goding Ramos (head & chest). Background: any distinctive Aklanon place or tourism attraction.
- Contestants should start from zero; they should not bring any prepared outlines/sketches/templates.
- Contestants should bring their own art materials. They can use any painting/coloring material (e.g. acrylic, oil, watercolor, pastel, etc.).
- Contestants can use any drawing surface (e.g. paper, canvas, cloth, etc.) as long as its size should be 15x20 (A3 size).
- Entries will be judged according to originality, art style and relevance to the topic.

Terms and Qualifications

- No inappropriate references (drugs, alcohol, violence, profanity, sex, etc.) allowed.
- Submit only original artworks.
- All artworks will become property of the Museo it Akean, but the artist still retains ownership over his/her artwork.
- By submitting an artwork, you automatically grant the Museo it Akean non-exclusive, royalty-free, irrevocable license to use and publicly display the content.
- By participating, you agree to release, discharge, and hold harmless the Museo it Akean from any and all liability, loss, damage, or injury resulting from participation in this contest.

Cash Prizes

- There shall be twelve (12) winners. All 12 artworks shall be featured in a calendar commemorating Goding Ramos (1 artwork = 1 month).
- First Place – Php 5,000.00
- Second Place – Php 3,500.00
- Third Place – Php 2,500.00
- Nine (9) Honorable Mentions – Php 1,000.00 each.
