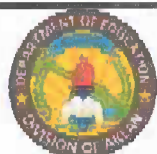

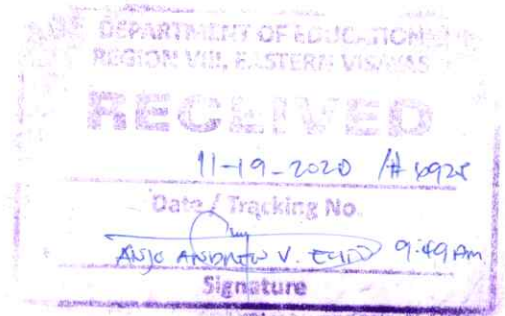

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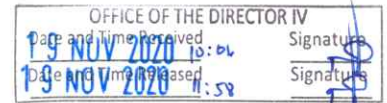

Subject: **INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE 2020 CLIMATE SCIENCE MASTER CLASS**

Relative to OUA Memo 00-1120-0154 on the *Invitation to Participate in the 4th National Climate Change Conference and National Day of Youth For Climate Action from 19-25 November 2020*, the Department of Education (DepEd) through the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service (DRRMS) and the Climate Change Commission (CCC) will hold the **Climate Science Master Class for High School Teachers** on **24 November 2020, 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.** as part of the learning session of the 4th National Climate Change Consciousness Conference (NCCC) celebrated during the annual Global Warming and Climate Change Consciousness Week.

To ensure that the webinar will contain the most recent climate science, the **sessions will be delivered by members of the National Panel of Technical Experts (NPTE)** as lead technical advisory body on climate science and technology. Filipino Sign Language interpretation will be provided. The Master Class will be **streamed live** through the **DepEd Philippines Facebook Page**, making it accessible to learners, DepEd personnel, and the public all over the country. However, only those who are in the meeting room will be given a certificate.

In line with this, interested DepEd personnel are invited to register at <https://bit.ly/ClimateScienceMasterClass>. All divisions and regions are enjoined to share this memorandum to the respective teaching personnel. **Each division is given ten slots (for eight high school teachers in any subject or principals and two slots for the division office - the CID Chief and DRRM Coordinator). Each regional office is given two slots (for the CLMD Chief and the Regional DRRM Coordinator).** Interested central office personnel may also register. To ensure that all regions and divisions are represented, only the first ten personnel who will register per division will be accommodated. Should other regions and divisions not fill their slot, it shall be distributed to those who registered early.
