Greetings of love and peace!

Over the years, Altavas National School (ANS) has been a perennial top performing school in the field of journalism in the Division of Aklan. ANS has been a hotbed of campus journalists and young writers who have gone on to win in local, regional and national competitions. This is primarily due to the training and workshops that ANS writers have participated in.

As the Division Schools Press Conference (DSPC) is fast approaching, Altavas National School will be conducting the first-ever JOURN CAMP 2018, a three-day journalism writeshop, on August 31 to September 2, 2018 at Altavas National School. Journ Camp seeks to intensively train budding campus journalists and school paper advisers from the Eastern side of Aklan and nearby towns of Capiz. In particular, the event aims to reach out to writers from far-flung schools who could not afford to join in journalism trainings in Kalibo and Iloilo City. Participants will be housed at Altavas National School for the duration of the activity. Registration fee is Php250.00/participant that will cover expenses for training materials, certificates and medals and other logistical needs, food and honoraria for lecturers and lights and sounds for the entire duration of the event.

Journ Camp will feature award-winning coaches and professionals as lecturers. The categories to be discussed are Editorial Writing, News Writing, Sports Writing, Feature Writing, Copyreading and Headline Writing, Cartooning and Photojournalism. There will be separate sessions for student journalists and school paper advisers to better equip them for contests. Through this, it is hoped that schools will be encouraged and equipped to put up their own school publications, in line with the goal of Campus Journalism Act of 1991 to promote press freedom in schools.

In this regard, we respectfully request your good office to allow us to hold this activity on the abovementioned dates and venue. Likewise, we humbly request for a Division Memorandum endorsing this event so we can formally invite schools to join this meaningful undertaking. Your full support to this noble endeavor is a big step towards our goal of honing and producing the next generation of champion writers in Aklan.
