
WASH IN SCHOOLS (WINS) PROGRAM

As part of the Department of Education's (DepEd) response to COVID-19 through capacity-building of its personnel, the Office of the Undersecretary for Administration (OUA) through the Bureau of Learner Support Services - School Health Division (BLSS-SHD) is implementing a series of Massive Open Online Courses (MOOC) on Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (WASH) in Schools (WinS) as a digital training solution to uniformly convey the program's messaging to target audiences.

Under the current pandemic situation, improvement of WASH at the school level has become a requirement to meet the minimum health standards and ensure that proper hygiene will be practiced by learners, parents, and DepEd personnel (e.g., parents submitting and picking up modules in schools, etc.) and also once schools reopen at some point in the future (DepEd Order No. 014, s. 2020.)

In this regard, two self-paced WinS MOOC courses, to be managed by respective regions under the supervision of the BLSS-SHD and GIZ personnel, will be offered for school-level participants and for division personnel from September 2021 to November 2021. #### Leading WinS

School-level WinS MOOC designed for school heads and teachers to effectively implement WinS in their respective schools by learning the WinS policy, monitoring the program and planning for improvements

In preparation for this, an Online Capacity Development Workshop for Regional Course Management Teams will be conducted on 15 and 16 July 2021 from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

The workshop aims to familiarize course managers from the region on the use of Moodle platform of the DepEd Learning Management System (DepEd LMS), contents, navigating the courses, and course management elements.

Each region is given four (4) slots which shall comprise the **Regional Course**Management Team. Participants may be the Regional WinS Coordinator, HR personnel (if applicable), IT personnel, and Division WinS-SBM Coordinator.
