
PARTICIPANTS IN THE 2018 XIX MARTYRS CELEBRATION

1. Enclosed is a letter from the Kalibo Municipal Mayor, Honorable William S. Lachica, regarding the celebration of the XIX Martyrs of Aklan. One of the highlights of the said activity is the Commemorative Program on March 23, 2018, 7:00 A.M. at the Aklan Freedom Shrine, 19 Martyrs St. Kalibo, Aklan.
2. DepED Aklan is invited to partner with the LGU for this celebration.
3. The Division Office and all districts shall be represented (see the minimum number of participants below) and advised to wear **mainly baro/kimona and saya for the females and camiza chino and pants (pajama style) for the males**. Others may wear other attires of Filipino men and women in the 1880s and 1890s. Women could be allowed to wear bakya, **abaca** slippers, or "Pantufila" **but not rubber** shoes/slippers as footwear, while men could wear **leather** shoes/boots/slippers or could walk barefoot. The Division Office and every district should see to it that their participants wear a variety of the abovementioned attires.
