## PHILIPPINE HISTORICAL TRAIL: SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON HISTORICAL PLACES IN KALIBO THROUGH TRAVELOGUE

1. The challenge in teaching History is influenced by the nature of the subject, teachers' competence and learners' attitude towards the course. Pupils learn best when the teacher provides activities that are cognitively challenging and they are actively engaged on it.

Historiography involves the study of the writing of history and provides the pupils the opportunities in learning the meaning of history and appreciate its value. Before the learners learn to become historians, teachers of history must be exposed to activities that will enable them to experience first-hand, what it is to be a historian. Thus, this training will help our Philippine History teachers, enhance their skills and competence in writing local history and making of meaningful and relevant support instructional materials.

- 2. In this light, DepEd-Aklan through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will conduct the **Philippine Historical Trail: Seminar-Workshop on Historical Places in Kalibo Through Travelogue** on **April 22-24** and **26**, **2019**, venue will be announced later.
- 3. The training aims to identify areas/topics in Philippine History for integration of lessons in local history, develop a lesson plan, travel brochure showing the integration of local history in teaching various topics in Philippine history, LAC plan; and quality assure the different lesson plans and travel brochures produced in teaching Philippine History.
- 4. Each district will send two (2) Araling Panlipunan teachers comprising of Grades 5-6 preferably the Araling Panlipunan teachers who attended the Division Enhancement Training in Teaching Philippine History Using Differentiated Instructions, Pedagogies and SIMS last September 27-29, 2018, one (1) District Elementary Araling Panlipunan Coordinator, one (1) District/School ICT Coordinator with knowledge in travelogue formatting using Microsoft Office and one (1) District Quality Assurance (QA) Coordinator who will attend only on the last day (April 26).

- 5. The **expenses** relative to the conduct of the said activity such as meals, venue, supplies, certificates, tarpaulin, reproduction of materials and other related expenses shall be charged against **Division HRTD Fund**. The travel expenses of the trainors/facilitators and participants shall be charged against school/local fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 6. Furthermore, trainers and teacher-participants are entitled to 4-day service credit where it applies in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 entitled: Updating Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers".
